


# Camp Wabanna Day Camp

## Drop off and Pick up

 Please follow posted speed limits through the neighborhood as you approach the camp; there are many homes with children nearby, so use caution.

- ❖ 101 Likes Road is our physical address.
- ❖ Drop off is at 8:30am Monday-Friday.  
If you registered for early care, drop off is at 7:30am and includes breakfast.
- ❖ Pick up is at 5:00pm Monday-Friday.

## Gift Shop & Pre-Order Pick Up

Our gift shop will be open at pick up on Monday and Thursday.

Pre-orders will be available at the gift shop during pick up on Monday.



## Bringing Medications

All medication whether prescription or over the counter, vitamins, supplements, ointments, EpiPens, or inhalers, must be:

1. In the original container or packaging and turned in and dispensed by our Health Room Supervisor, as required by Maryland State Law.
2. Accompanied by a "Medication Administration Authorization Form" that has been signed by their doctor. This includes over the counter medication, ointments, EpiPens and inhalers. Camp Wabanna may not administer anything without this signed form.
3. Included in a Ziploc bag labeled with camper's name (with the form as described above).

## What to Bring

- **Backpack**
- **Water Bottle**
- **Bathing Suit:** Campers should arrive to camp wearing their swimsuits under their clothes.
- **Beach Towel**
- **Sunscreen**
- **Bible:** In a Ziploc bag since it will be in their bag with wet towels and clothes.
- **Change of Clothes**
- **Bug Spray**
- **Proper Footwear:** Shoes that can get dirty & walk across uneven terrain. Closed toed shoes required for low & high ropes activities.



## Please Don't Bring

- Cell phones or tablets
- Smart Watches

**Please be sure to put your camper's name on all belongings. This way we can make sure to return items to campers if they are lost!**

## What We Provide

We provide lunch, a snack, and snack shop for day campers each day.

- ❖ For day camp the snack shop fee is included in the registration fee.
- ❖ If your camper has any special food service needs, be sure to inform us on the allergies form.

## Cancellation Policy

Cancellations must be made in writing by email to Wabanna. Cancellations before June 1<sup>st</sup> will result in the loss of the non-refundable deposit of \$150. Any portion of the balance paid, less \$150, will be refunded. After June 1<sup>st</sup>, there are no refunds for cancellation for any reason. If a camper is unable to attend camp or misses days of camp for any reason, including illness, there will be no refund or credits given for missed days.
