

## **CORE Contractor's Building Performance Hub (BPH) Requirements for Partnership**

If currently enlisted as a preferred or approved contractor with Holy Cross Energy, Love Electric, Xcel, Collective Clean Energy Fund (CCEF), Colorado Energy Office Home energy rebate program (HEAR or HER), or Registered with EPA for Audits, this will satisfy BPH accreditation requirements.

### Requirements:

- Provide services for energy efficiency and/or electrification to clients in BPH service territory (Roaring Fork Valley, Garfield County, and/or Eagle County including the Vail Valley) and demonstrated ability to mobilize across territory
- Complete the [request for Information/ Qualifications](#)
- Demonstrate responsiveness to clients, with fewer than two documented complaints from CORE customers in the past two years.
- Demonstrates call back corrections for warrantable and workmanship issues for CORE customers.
- Hold all required licenses and registrations in the jurisdictions where they operate.
- Be familiar with COREs standard incentives and communicate to clients what those are.

### Accreditation qualifications suggested for selection

- Accredited training in energy efficiency respective of trade to demonstrate competency in energy-efficient systems.
  - a. BPI certifications
  - b. Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy - Energy Skilled Recognition (<https://bsesc.energy.gov/recognition>)
  - c. Alternate specialized energy efficiency training program certification/recognition for respective trade. (cold climate heat pump training).
  - d. Advocates for electrification and energy efficiency
