## Activating Direct Deposit (Mobile)

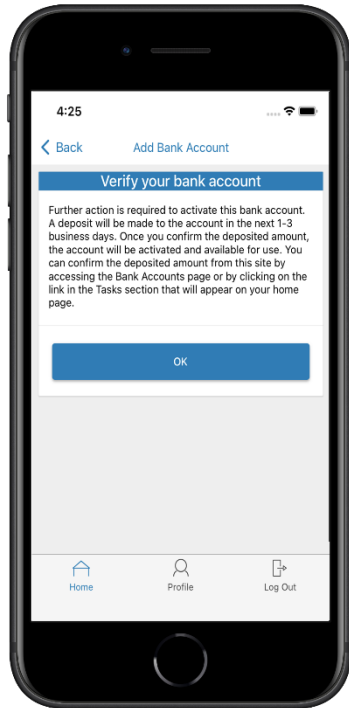
- 1) Consumer goes to "Manage Bank Account" page from the profile tab.



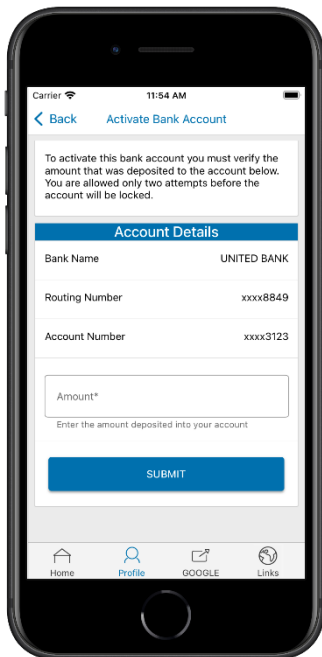
- 2) Consumer enters bank account information.
