# **Purpose**

The HOPE worldwide National Youth Advisory Council's mission is to provide vision, counsel and creative solutions as servant leaders while engaging fellow youth volunteers in meaningful, ongoing, relationship-oriented service to the materially poor. This service should spring from our relationship with God and loving others as Jesus does.

The purpose of your position as a council member is to capture and share the heart of Jesus through ministering to and journeying with the hungry, the materially poor, the elderly, the sick, the disaster-struck and the brokenhearted. Each NYAC member is to unify youth to serve locally through designing fundraising and service efforts and mobilizing volunteers. To accomplish this, members are to collaborate with local chapter leaders, ministry leaders, community partners and youth volunteers to better serve and meet a variety of significant needs in respectful and effective ways.

## **Duties and Responsibilities**

Members serve a 1-year term and may apply for subsequent terms until aging out of program at the end of the term following college graduation. This position requires time and commitment. Please count the cost before applying to determine whether you will be able to meet requirements.

Members who do not continue to meet expectations may be asked to step down prior to the end of term.

## **General Requirements:**

- Honor God and self through interactions with council, volunteers, staff and community
- Work alongside & with approval of chapter & church leaders in ministry of helping and healing
- Participate in at least 9 of 11 monthly training calls focused on leadership and nonprofit training
- Read a book on servant-leadership and share highlights with your cohort
- Support local chapter and its leadership team; may include participating in meetings
- Offer youth perspective to National Chapter Advisory Board, Chapter Directors and HOPE staff
- Utilize social media to garner support and to inspire and celebrate what God accomplishes
- Maintain a close relationship with Chapter Leader to ensure community partnerships are sustainable beyond NYAC participation
- Respond within 48 hours to all NYAC related emails, Slack messages, phone calls.
- May be asked to participate in various subcommittees: Social Media, SLA Planning, Selection
- Submit photos and data on NYAC service & fundraising efforts within one week of completion

#### **Fundraisers**

• Design, organize and operate a fundraiser to benefit HOPEww Youth Programs with the goal of raising a minimum of \$1000.

## **Passion Programs**

- Work with local HOPEworldwide chapter leader to select a need about which you are passionate that effects the materially poor in your community
- Partner with a local organization related to that need if beneficial to do so
- Organize and participate in an ongoing relational project that will help address that need
- Include local community members (fellow church members, classmates, community members)

#### **Summer 2023**

- Training Event: participate in weeklong NYAC Servant Leadership Academy (SLA) in La Misión, Mexico in Summer 2023.
- This is the capstone event of your NYAC term and should take priority over other activities including HYC or Teen Camps.

#### Qualifications

NYAC members should be keen on initiating new ideas and projects and must possess exemplary leadership and communication skills. Members must:

- Be a disciple of Jesus with a dynamic walk with God
- Be in good standing with your church
- Be a responsible, organized, dedicated, dependable, and hardworking leader
- Have the desire and ability to lead other young volunteers
- Have a previous demonstrated track record of local service
- Be a current college student or high school student
- Have a GPA of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale
- Submit \$225 annual membership dues, which will be reinvested in YOU
- Receive strong recommendation from HOPE worldwide chapter director & ministry leader
- Have the time and ability to orchestrate a service program and fundraisers
