

<u>Join Us for Bible Study with Monsignor Koons:</u> <u>"The Advent of the Messiah"</u>

The coming of God's Son to earth is an event of such immensity that God willed to prepare for it over the centuries. He makes everything converge on Christ: all the rituals and sacrifices, figures and symbols of the "First Covenant." He announces him through the mouths of the prophets who succeeded one another in Israel. Moreover, he awakens in the hearts of the pagans a dim expectation of this coming.

The word "advent" comes from the Latin "adventus", meaning "an arrival." For centuries, the children of Israel faithfully awaited the advent of the promised Redeemer-Messiah. God first promised a future Redeemer after humanity's fall in Eden, cursing the serpent and assuring that Satan's power would one day end. Centuries later, the prophet Isaiah foretold that a virgin from the House of David would bear the Davidic Messiah. In the winter of 3/2 BC, the time arrived for the Redeemer-Messiah—promised since Adam and Eve's fall—to undo Satan's work and redeem humanity.

Prepare for Advent (Sunday, November 30) and Christmas this year with a Bible Study of "The Advent of the Messiah" and help to deepen your understanding of this beautiful mystery with Monsignor Koons.
