Lebanon: With the ongoing conflict in the Middle East Tearfund Ireland partners in Lebanon share: 'This moment is one of immense magnitude, one that could drastically reshape the region for decades to come. At this time, we are specifically asking that people pray for: Peace and justice in our region; the protection and safety of civilians; wisdom and restraint among decision makers and global leaders; comfort for families and reconciliation and healing between nations.'
