From the Faith Formation Director

I am so thrilled you are interested in registering your child for Faith Formation! Our Catholic faith is a beautiful gift. The more children learn about Jesus, the deeper their relationship with Him grows. Our goal is to help them know, love, and serve Him now, so they can experience true joy in this life and eternal happiness in Heaven.

Sacramental Years

First Holy Communion (usually 2nd grade) and Confirmation (10th grade and older) be prepared to dive in deeper these years. This includes, meetings throughout the year, retreats, and studying the faith at home with parents, and for Confirmands, their sponsors. These sacraments will be celebrated in April, after a school year of formation. Classes begin Sept 23.

CARITAS Grades 7-10

This year, St. Francis and Sacred Heart will begin the CARITAS program. CARITAS is a small group faith formation model for grades 7-10. By using a small group model, catechists will better encounter, encourage, and foster relationships with students, leading them to a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ. CARITAS consists of a three year cycle of content, following the first three sections of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC), and the two CARITAS pillars of relationship and prayer will be a consistent emphasis. Classes begin Sept 23 at 6:45. Students in grades 7-10 will also participate in J-Term classes, learning about discernment, courtship, chastity, and love.

Faith Formation Grades 1-6

After school classes will begin September 23 and run through April 28. Class ends at 5:00pm. New this year – CatholicHOM Family meetings! High School LEAD

New to our area is an exciting program for our 11-12 graders who have been confirmed. LEAD (Leadership, Evangelization, and Discipleship) is designed for teens who want to lead and dive deeper in their faith. Activities include studies, engaging in the spiritual and corporal works of mercy, conferences, and pilgrimages. LEAD will meet at Jimmy's pizza for the initial gathering in September with directors Emily and Samantha! LEAD youth are also invited to participate in our J-Term classes.
