The meals need to be adequate for at least 10-15 people and need to be re-heatable/microwaveable. A box will be in the kitchen for non-perishable food goods on the counter next to the refrigerator. A box in the refrigerator will be for perishable goods.

Donations work too! \$75 feeds families for a few days. Vickie will do the shopping and meal prep for those who donate funds.

Delivery can be at LPC office before 3 pm, Monday through Thursday, and before 1 pm on Fridays.
