

- Hospitality: Welcoming new members and guests, creating a warm and inclusive environment within the church.
- Grief Support: Providing ministry to those navigating loss or hardship.
- Home Communion and Visitation: Coordinating care for homebound members to ensure their continued connection with the church.
- Care Calendar: Managing schedules for meals, visits, or other assistance during life transitions or challenges.
