Affirmation of Faith

The Nicene Creed is the most ecumenical of creeds. The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) joins with Eastern Orthodox, Roman Catholic, and most Protestant churches in affirming it.

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven, was incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary and became truly human. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

CELEBRATE Ministry (Worship)

The CELEBRATE Ministry is responsible for overseeing and coordinating all aspects of worship, ensuring that each service is meaningful and spiritually enriching. This ministry is led by two to three elders and it manages the preparation of the worship space, the elements of worship, and the technology required for both in-person and online services.

Key responsibilities include:

- Worship Services: Planning and coordinating regular worship services and special services (e.g., Service of Wholeness, Service of Thanks, Blessing of the Animals).
- Worship Space and Elements: Ensuring the appropriate setup of the worship space and the necessary elements for each service.
- Technology and Online Worship: Overseeing the production and delivery of online worship services, including technology setup and live-streaming.
- Acolytes: Managing the scheduling and training of acolytes to assist in worship.
- Visitor Connections and Follow-up: Welcoming and connecting visitors to the church, including follow-up communication to foster relationships.

The CELEBRATE Ministry seeks to create worship experiences that honor God and build a strong sense of community among members and visitors alike.
