SERVE Ministry (Mission, Outreach, and Evangelism)

The SERVE Ministry leads the church's efforts to share Christ's love beyond its walls, both locally and globally. This ministry is led by two to four elders and it oversees programs and activities that foster community engagement, support mission partners, and promote outreach and evangelism.

Key responsibilities include:


- Community Outreach and Engagement: Organizing events such as Trunk or Treat and the Easter Egg Hunt to build relationships with the local community.
- Mission Partnerships: Collaborating with mission partners like UCOM, iCare, and Sulzbacher to support their initiatives and serve those in need.
- Mission Trips: Promoting, planning, and supporting mission trips to provide hands-on opportunities for service and faith-sharing.
- Exploring New Opportunities: Identifying and pursuing additional ways to engage and serve the community.
- Lakewood Presbyterian Preschool: LPP provides a quality, Christ-centered preschool
 education in a loving environment. An elder from the Session serves on the LPP Board,
 which includes parents, teachers, and church members. The board meets monthly and
 reports to the Session. The preschool operates under the leadership of the director, who is a
 member of the LPC staff. LPP is one of the most significant ways the church connects with
 and serves the community.

The SERVE Ministry is committed to extending the reach of the church's mission, empowering members to live out their faith in service to others.
