

For the week of December 14 - 20



This year during Advent, I have been reading from *Anne Neilson's Christmas Angels: Devotions and Art of Hope and Joy for the Advent Season.* The first week I grasped on to this simple sentence. *If you seek God during this Advent season, you will find him.* Too many times, I *think about* seeking God during advent, and I *mean* to seek God during advent, but when it comes down to it, I don't ever get around to *doing* the seeking. Too many other things get in the way. This year when I read that sentence, I was challenged to make it a point to really *do* the seeking, and I can say that Anne Neilson was right. As I have been seeking, I have been finding God who has been with me all along. Sometimes I feel like God is distant and my faith feels weak. I'm sure you have times like this in your own lives, too. Times of spiritual doubt and dryness are part of the journey, but even though we pass through them, we don't have to stay stuck in them.

Christmas is the time when we remember that God is with us. There is never a time when we are alone or when God is inaccessible to us, but there are times when we don't draw near, and we don't pay attention, and we don't actively participate in our relationship with God. Sometimes the distance that we feel isn't because God has moved but because we have. The Holy Spirit sparked something in me when I read that line in my devotional, and I share this with you in the hopes that the Spirit might spark something in any of you who may be feeling dry or distant. If you seek God, during this Advent season or anytime, you will find God. I believe this is true, and Christmas confirms it! God wants to be found. It is why God became flesh and came to us. As we celebrate the birth of Jesus, may we all do everything we can to draw near to the One who has drawn near to us.




The CARE Ministry has received more Christmas cards than needed. A box of those cards has been placed in the session room. Please feel free to take them for your personal use.
