Kindergarten (K5) Requirements:

- NC Law requires students to be five years old on or before August 31 of the current school year.
- Prior to the start of school, a health assessment and an updated immunization record must be on file.

To Enroll Your Child, Please Complete the Following:

- Submit an application accompanied by the \$75.00 application fee (non-refundable).
- Family interview with the administration - Both parents and their child should attend.
- Financial contract signed & dated
- Activate FACTS Tuition Management Account (payment plans available)
- Submit Book fees
- Student handbook read and agreement signed
- A Medical Emergency Information form completed and notarized

Please Submit the Following Documents:

- A certified copy of the child's birth certificate.
*A birth certificate may be obtained from the county or state health department where the child was born.
- A copy of the child's Social Security card.
- Kindergarten health assessment (Before the first day of school)
- A copy of an updated immunization record
- A copy of both parents/ guardians' driver licenses

When all the above steps are complete, your child will be enrolled in WCA's K5.
