HARNESS HORSEMEN INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC. QUALIFICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS



The HARNESS HORSEMEN INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC. (HHIF, INC.) will annually grant a \$4,000 college scholarship at \$2,000 per school year for two years for full-time student as follow:

The Jerome L. Hauck Scholarship

Eligibility: The candidate must be a child of a full-time groom and a member of an HHI association, or a child of a member of an HHI member association.

Educational requirements: The candidate must be a senior at any secondary school or a previous high school graduate or first or second year college student. The applicant must have taken either the S.A.T. or A.C.T. test or Canadian equivalent.

Financial need: The financial need of the candidate will be considered and estimated on the basis of the parents/legal guardians' annual income, any financial contributions from other sources, and any special family circumstances.

Extra-curricular and community service participation: The extent to which a candidate has participated in and contributed to the life and welfare of school and/or community will be taken into account, including your participation in harness racing.

Standards for consideration: An applicant for this scholarship will be judged by criteria which in addition to those listed above include scholarship, citizenship and leadership. Evidence of character and personality is sought and will be reviewed with care.

APPLICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

Applications will be available at all HHI member associations' offices as well as from HHI and on their website.

In order to properly advance the interest of the applicant and to conserve the time of the committee, all material presented should be orderly, concise and chronological. Exhibits evidencing notable achievements may be attached, but the applicant should avoid repetitious accounts.

- Applicants must include, in the order indicated the following:
- 1. Two letters of recommendation, neither over 200 words, one from a school official and one from a member of the community;
- 2. An official transcript (signed, stamped, and sealed in an envelope) which shows the most recent rank in class and the scores obtained on a national test, either S.A.T. or A.C.T. or the Canadian equivalent.

- 3. A formal letter of endorsement and presentation signed by the President or the Executive Director/General Manager/etc. of the HHI member association sponsoring the applicant.
- 4. A recent color or black and white wallet size photo of the applicant.

Applications that do not conform substantially to the above requirements will not be considered. However, in the event that a candidate's academic achievements are not reflected by grades and tests, other attributes must be provided.

FILING OF APPLICATIONS

The completed application and all inclusions must be filed on or before **May 1** to the Harness Horsemen International Foundation office.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

The Harness Horsemen International Foundation, Inc., through this program seeks students of outstanding merit who show an appreciation of the value of an education and who are willing to achieve success. It is noted that the student must remain a full-time student and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average. If for reasons of health or other emergencies the student does not remain enrolled full-time, he must receive approval from the Trustees in order to qualify for subsequent scholarship payments. As a condition precedent in awarding the scholarship the HHIF, INC. Board of Trustees reserves unto itself the right to cancel or otherwise terminate a grant at any time an awardees', in the opinion of the Trustees, directly or indirectly engages in undesirable activities.

The scholarship will be paid to the College or University by the HHIF, Inc. on behalf of the student. The applicants will be judged by an outside group not affiliated with Harness Horsemen International or the Foundation. These rules are subject to change by the Board of Trustees from time to time.

Both the recipient and the non-winners of the Jerome L. Hauck Scholarship will be notified by mail on or about the third week in July.
