CLINICAL APPROACH & SERVICES

Dr. Baldwin specializes in chronic pain, neuropathy and complex conditions that may have responded incompletely to conventional care.

Care options may include:

- Acupuncture therapy, electroacupuncture and auricular acupuncture
- Orthopedic and pain-focused acupuncture; neuropathy-focused protocols
- Chinese herbal medicine and frequency-specific microcurrent
- Acupuncture point injection therapy
- Medical ozone and platelet-rich plasma (PRP) therapies, when clinically appropriate

Treatment recommendations follow an individual consultation and are selected for clinical appropriateness.

WHAT PROVIDERS CAN EXPECT

1

Confirm Receipt & Scheduling

Verify referral receipt, scheduling status, and any contact issues, cancellations, declined visits, or no-shows.

2

Provide a Timely Consultation Summary

Share key findings, assessment, testing, treatment, medication changes, follow-up recommendations, and urgent results.

3

Provide Monthly Progress Reports

Send regular updates on the patient's treatment, response to care, progress, and recommended next steps.

WHAT PATIENTS CAN EXPECT

1

Comprehensive consultation

Review of symptoms, medical history, prior treatments, mobility and nerve-related concerns, and relevant lifestyle factors.

2

Personalized care plan

A plan tailored to the patient's health picture and goals. Most acupuncture visits last about 25-35 minutes; initial visits may be longer.

3

Progress review

Symptoms and function are reassessed over time, with treatment adjustments made as clinically appropriate.
