Leading off...

Today's Game: The Ottawa Titans are in action, continuing their fifth season in franchise history, with a doubleheader to continue a four-game series against the New Jersey Jackals... RHP's **Alfredo Villa** and **Ky Hampton** will get the start for the Titans, opposed by Jackals' RHP **Ruben Ramirez** and **TBA**... the Titans are coming off a series sweep at TC, ROX & TR x2, win against QUE, NY, SC, TC x2, NJ, DE, TR x2, & ROX x3... lost a series to SC, T-C, QUE x3, NJ x2, DE, NY x3, WC, & GAT... split with SC & MIS... just missed out on the 2025 playoffs by 1.5 games, despite a run for the ages throughout the final 2 months of the season... after starting 11-24, the Club rattled off a 14 series unbeaten streak and went 40-21 down the stretch.

Last Game: **Ottawa 7, New Jersey 4**... The Titans grinded out fourth win a row, powered by three homers to take the series opener... Jackie Urbaez hit a leadoff homer in the first for his 11th of the year, Hunter Stokely went yard for a solo homer in the fifth for his 10th of the season, and AJ Wright's 14th of the campaign was the dagger - blasting a go-ahead grand slam in the eighth to cap off the comeback win... Taylor Wright opened, allowing 2 runs in the first inning - then Dominic Puccetti carried the bulk, allowing 2 runs over 5 frames, issuing a season-high tying 5 walks... Michael Vilchez threw a scoreless eighth, while Christian Scafi recorded the save with a clean ninth... Jack Kalisky picked up a huge RBI double... Caleb Burr picked up 2 hits... Jackie Urbaez walked twice... the Titans hold a 1.5-game lead over New York for the top Wild Card... the Titans are in the playoffs for the third time in five seasons.

On Deck: The Ottawa Titans wrap up in New Jersey over the weekend to end the campaign.... the 2026 Frontier League Playoffs are slated to begin September 9, with the best 2-of-3 Wild Card Series... the Titans will host Game One against an opponent TBD.

Headlines...

The Titans went 51-45 during their 2025 campaign, going 824-3187 (.259 AVG), scored 513 runs, hit 61 homers, and drove in 456... led by AJ Wright, who only went 80-326 (.245) but had team highs with 23 doubles, 10 homers, and 55 RBI... The pitching staff tossed to a 5.32 ERA in 829.1 IP... Billy Doby contributed a 2.81 ERA over 48 innings pitched, while Alfredo Villa went 10-4 on the season, coming just short of the franchise record 11 wins.

THE MAGNET: Jackie Urbaez became the Frontier League's all-time record holder for career hit-by-pitches in New York on June 21, 2025, with his 106th hit-by-pitch... the Miami product surpassed Junior Arrojio (Florence, 2011-2013) 105 for the mark... it took Urbaez 336 games to break the record.. Urbaez played for Sussex County in 2021 and has been in Canada's capital since the inaugural 2022 season.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: For the fifth consecutive season, the Titans will send multiple representatives to the mid-summer classic... AJ Wright was named to his third All-Star team, while Kaleb Hill, Eric Pardiho, and Brett Garcia were each named to their first All-Star teams.

PARDINHO PERFECTION: Eric Pardiho took home Pitcher of the Week honours for the slate of games from June 30 to July 5... it marks the first time since 2024 in which the Titans have had a weekly award winner... Pardiho threw the first no-hitter in franchise history in a rain-shortened game against Tri-City with 8 strikeouts, coming 3 outs shy of a perfect game... he took the loss on 7/5, tossing 6.1 innings, allowing 4 runs on 5 hits.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: During the 2025 season, Canadian Taylor Wright stole 18 bags, being caught only once all season... He holds the franchise record with 94 stolen bases while holding a career 92 SB%... he reset the franchise record in 2026, with 30 bags.

SEASONED VETS: AJ Wright leads the franchise with 61 career home runs and 291 RBI... AJ Wright is just the fourth player in Frontier League history with 10+ homers in 5-straight seasons... Jackie Urbaez sits in second with 43 home runs and 216 RBI... They aren't just big names to the fans but leaders in the clubhouse... Both in their 5th seasons with the Titans, they continue to write the record book.

FROM THE FARM TO THE FRONTIER: This season, the Titans boast 16 players with MiLB experience... A franchise record, the Titans hope this experience translates on the field by bringing the team back to the playoffs, something that hasn't happened since the 2024 season.

Bobby Brown inked a multi-year extension following the 2024 season... the 51-year-old brings over 20 years of professional baseball experience as a player, coach, scout, and Manager to the Nation's Capital... Brown previously managed in the American Association for Amarillo and Lincoln, winning Manager of the Year in 2017... before Ottawa, Brown was the Hitting Coach for Missoula in the Pioneer League... in his playing days, Brown finished with a career .301 average, with 368 RBI in 623 career games... Brown is no stranger to baseball north of the border as he suited up for the Northern League's Winnipeg Goldeyes (2000-2002), then the Canadian Baseball League's Saskatoon Legends (2003).

Eric Marriott comes to Ottawa after serving four seasons as head coach for the Moose Jaw Miller Express of the Western Canadian Baseball League. After 10 years of pro ball,

Rodrigo Orozco comes on as Hitting Coach. The ex-AAA player in both the Blue Jays and Padres organizations and former Frontier League All-Star is ready to bring a wealth of hard-earned knowledge to the Titans lineup.... he returns to Ottawa after being a member of the inaugural 2022 playoff Club.

Relief Pitcher turned Pitching Coach **Brandon Marklund** appeared in 36 games during the 2025 season, and now steps into the dugout in a new role, bringing a fresh perspective and firsthand experience to Ottawa's pitching staff. He will both coach and pitch this season.

History vs. New Jersey

Ottawa is 5-4 this year and 28-20 all-time vs. the Jackals, 18-5 at home, 10-15 road. Last year, OTT won the season series 5-4.

Big Picture: Only player on on the Ottawa Titans roster from Arizona... second in franchise history (Jacob Talamante, 2022-2023)... Son of Alfredo and Kathleen... Hails from Tucson, Arizona, but now lives in Phoenix.

College Days: Attended NCAA Div. 2 Adams State University (Alamosa, CO) from 2020-2022.. nicknamed the "Grizzlies"... In 25 collegiate contests (24 starts, one in relief), the 6-foot right-hander was a lifetime 11-8 for the Grizzlies with a 5.85 ERA – walking 30 and fanning 147 in 143 career innings... 2021 RMAC All-Academic Honor Roll and RMAC Honorable Mention All Conference.

Professional Debut: Villa made his professional debut during the 2022 season with the Grand Junction Rockies (now Jackalopes), winning the league title. That year, he was 7-1 with a 3.13 ERA – primarily pitching out of the bullpen.

2023 for the Ages: Villa became the first pitcher since 2000 to win the Triple Crown. In 18 starts, Villa was 13-1 with a 2.82 ERA – striking out 129 over 108.2 innings of work. With that, Villa was named to the league All-Star Team and earned Pitcher of the Year honours.

Final Pioneer League Season: Villa made 19 appearances (18 starts, one in relief) going 9-2 over 102 innings of work, tossing to a 5.12 ERA – while striking out 114... Villa hurled seven or more innings on five occasions while giving his team ten quality starts... Named a midseason all-star, Villa earned two Player of the Week nods, including July Pitcher of the Month – where he went 5-0 with an impressive 1.91 ERA, a league-low for all starting pitchers while recording 41 strikeouts in the process... Overall, he was a career 29-4 with a 3.74 ERA in 57 appearances (43 starts, 14 in relief) throughout his Pioneer League career – walking 97 and striking out 324... Villa also owned a lifetime 10.6 SO/9 in 274 innings of work.

Back in Ottawa: Returns to Ottawa as a key returning piece from last year's starting rotation. In 19 total appearances (18 starts), Villa led the team with a 10-4 record, tossing to a 4.33 ERA across 93.1 innings pitched – walking 42 and striking out 98 opposing hitters. The right-hander became the second arm in franchise history to eclipse ten victories in a season (Zac Wescott, 12 wins in 2022).

From June 8 through August 20, Villa was victorious in ten of a possible 14 contests – while having wins in three-straight starts twice, and a streak of four wins in a row. Villa also became the first pitcher in franchise history to strike out ten or more opposing hitters in back-to-back starts (11 versus Sussex County on June 8 and 10 versus Trois-Rivières on June 14). In 11 starts, Villa reached five innings pitched while allowing three earned runs or fewer. He completed the season with five quality starts, tied for second on the team.

After the 2025 Frontier League season, he was traded back to the Missoula PaddleHeads of the Pioneer League for a playoff run, tossing seven quality innings – allowing just two runs on six hits, striking out six. In the winter, Villa helped the Leones de Leon capture the Nicaraguan Winter League championship.

Hailing from Mount Barker, South Australia, Hampton's baseball journey has taken him from representing his country on the international stage to competing professionally in Australia and North America. A product of the Adelaide baseball system, Hampton emerged as one of Australia's top young arms, earning selection to the Australian National Team at the 2017 WBSC U-18 Baseball World Cup. He starred during the tournament, posting a 0.79 ERA and throwing a complete-game shutout against Chinese Taipei, helping establish himself as one of the country's premier pitching prospects.

Hampton began his professional career with the Adelaide Bite (now Adelaide Giants) in the Australian Baseball League while still a teenager before moving to the United States to continue his development at Eastern Illinois University. Across four collegiate seasons with the Panthers, he became a dependable member of the starting rotation, highlighted by a breakout 2023 campaign in which he posted a 7-3 record and ranked among the Ohio Valley Conference leaders in victories. His consistency and competitiveness earned him recognition as one of the conference's top starters while preparing him for the professional ranks.

Following his collegiate career, Hampton continued to represent Australia internationally, suiting up for the national team at the 2023 Asian Professional Baseball Championship. He delivered three scoreless innings in his tournament start against Chinese Taipei, adding another impressive performance while wearing his country's colours. During the Australian Baseball League seasons that followed, Hampton remained a key contributor for the Adelaide Giants, continuing to refine his repertoire against high-level competition. In 2026, he recorded a 2.70 ERA with 14 strikeouts in 13.1 innings for Adelaide before returning to North America.

Hampton entered the Frontier League in 2026 with the Down East Bird Dawgs before being acquired by the Ottawa Titans during the season. Known for his poise, strike-throwing ability, and extensive international experience, the Australian right-hander brings a unique blend of collegiate success, professional experience, and national team pedigree to the Titans' pitching staff as he continues his professional career.
