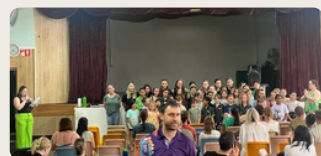

ASYCC Receives Major Grant to Enhance Gymnastics Facilities

We are proud to announce that the Alice Springs Youth and Community Centre has been awarded a generous \$103,545 grant from the Community Benefit Fund – NT Government. This significant investment will allow us to upgrade the gymnasium matting, ensuring a safer and more professional environment for our gymnastics program.

Our gymnastics program is one of the most active and inclusive in the region, operating six days a week and catering to over 150 students aged 5 to 18 years. These young athletes develop strength, coordination, and confidence through structured classes led by qualified coaches.



The new matting will address existing safety hazards and provide a high-quality surface that meets industry standards. This upgrade is not just about equipment—it's about creating a secure space where our youth can train, grow, and achieve their goals.

We extend our heartfelt thanks to the NT Government for recognizing the importance of community sport and supporting initiatives that empower young people. This grant will have a lasting impact on the health, wellbeing, and future opportunities of our local youth.

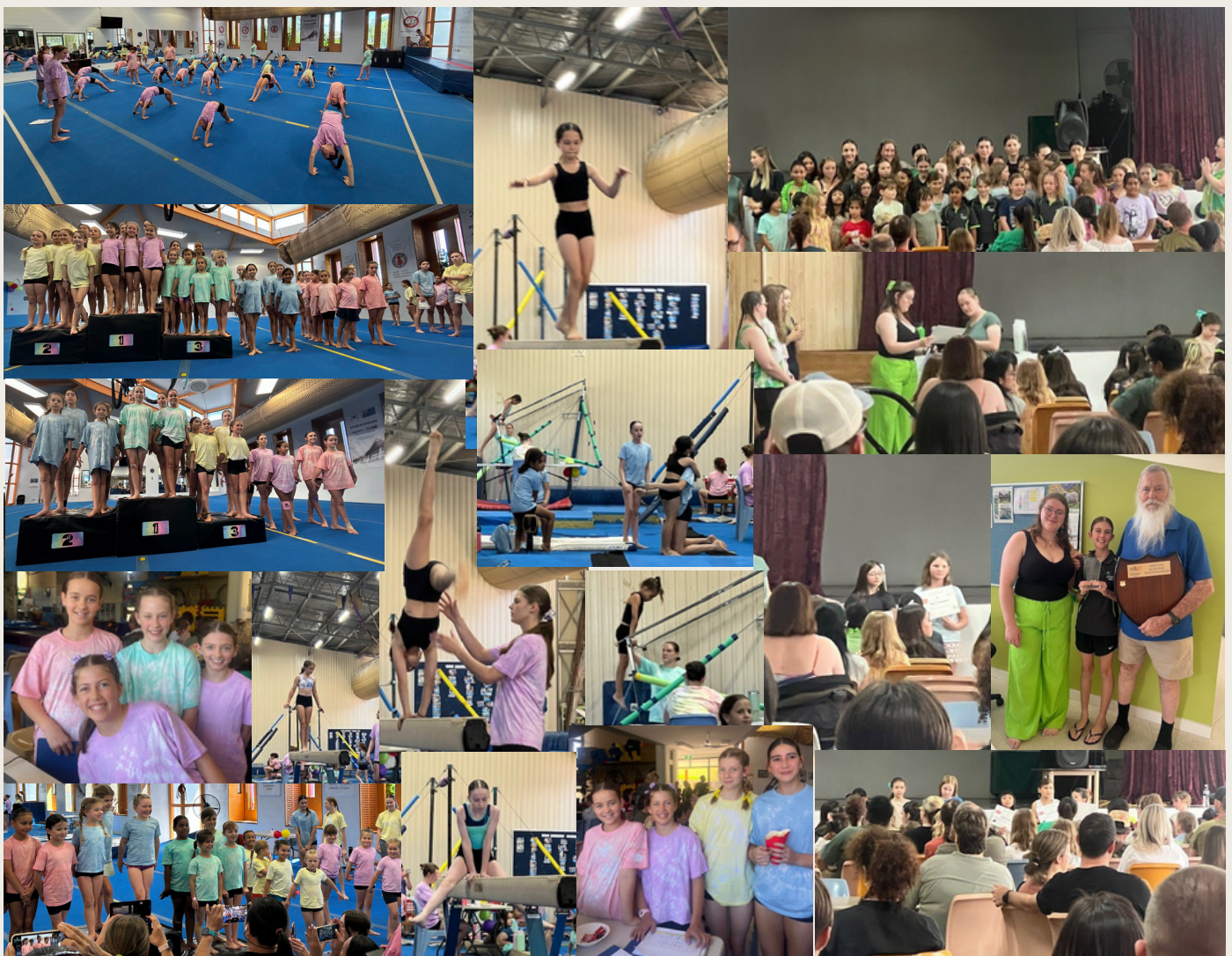
Gymnastics Annual Awards 2025
