However, comparisons between funeral homes must be made with care. Some firms may appear at first glance to be less costly because their service charge may be lower, yet other services and/or merchandise they provide may be higher. Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff **\$1,895.00**

Includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible party; coordination of funeral arrangements with clergy, cemetery, crematory and others involved in the final disposition; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral, including clerical assistance in the completion of Social Security, veterans affairs and insurance forms. Included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative cost, equipment and inventory cost. This fee for our basic service and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving of remains.)

NOTE for FAMILIES: Any clothing/blankets or cloth items not used for funeral services must be collected by family within 10 days of receiving the deceased into our care. Any clothing/blankets or other items will be disposed of after 10 days if arrangements are not made by the family to secure them.

Our charges for a direct cremation without any attendant rites of ceremony includes local removal, transportation to crematory, basic services of staff and cremation. It does not include a medical examiner's fee, if required. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of material like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are corrugated card board cremation containers.

PROFESSIONAL CARE AND PREPARATION OF THE DECEASED

Embalming is the scientific preparation and sanitary care of the body by licensed professionals using universal precautions for the protection of the public health. Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
