Dates: July 8-July 11, 2024 (Monday through Thursday)

Drop-off: 9:30am at the courtyard door

Pick-up: 1:00pm at the courtyard door

Lunch: Campers should pack a lunch. Each child should bring a water bottle each day clearly labeled with camper's name.

Dress: Campers should dress for both outdoor and messy activities. Sneakers or shoes which securely stay on feet are recommended as we will be running and jumping. No flipflops. The indoors is air conditioned but most of the activity will be outside weather permitting.

Sunblock/Bug Spray: Any sunblock or bug spray required by your child should be applied prior to coming to camp.

Medication: Should your child require medication during camp time, please contact Lynne Pabst nurture@grovepres.org prior to camp week so arrangements can be made in an appropriate manner.

COVID Procedures:

No Masks are required but are welcomed.

Hand-sanitizer is available throughout the day.

Handwashing takes place before and after lunch and appropriately after messy activities.

Any camper with a fever or COVID symptoms should be kept home.

Drop-off and Pick-up:

Campers are to be accompanied into the sign-in table by their responsible adult.

Campers are to be picked up at the sign-in table and must be signed out by their responsible person before leaving.

When the responsible adult is unknown to the camp staff, picture identification is required before the child is released.

Safety: Camp staff have clearances and Mandated Reporter Training.

It is planned to have a nurse present each day.

The 3-person rule is followed.
