In order to volunteer in any capacity at St. Pius X School, Diocesan policy requires verified attendance at a Protecting God's Children session and a cleared BCI background report. A second Diocesan policy requires families to agree to abide by the Volunteer code of Conduct, which is stated in our family handbook.

To register for Protecting God's Child course:

Open www.virtus.org From the homepage, click on "FIRST-TIME REGISTRANT" located in a green box on the left hand side of the page.

Next, click on the green arrow that says "View a List of All Sessions".

"Select your organization" COLUMBUS, OH (Diocese).

From here you will see a list of sessions available to schedule.

Please look through and determine a location and date that is convenient. Be mindful of any notes listed in RED as some of the sessions have special circumstances. Once a date/location is determined, please select "Start Registration". When you have attended the session, the Diocesan office will be notified.

To complete a BCI Background Report: Fast Fingerprints, www.fastfingerprints.com or Mobile Fingerprinting Solutions, Pickerington.

Provide volunteer code; 2151.86 and ask that the report be sent to the Diocese of Columbus when you check in. If you have not been a resident of Ohio for more than 5 years, you must also have an FBI Background Report completed, in addition to the BCI Background Report.
