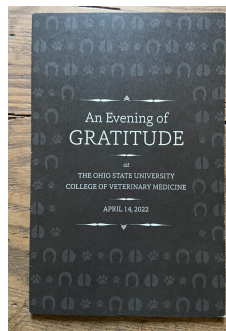
Hello Ladies,

Welcome to American National CattleWomen Region1 Members

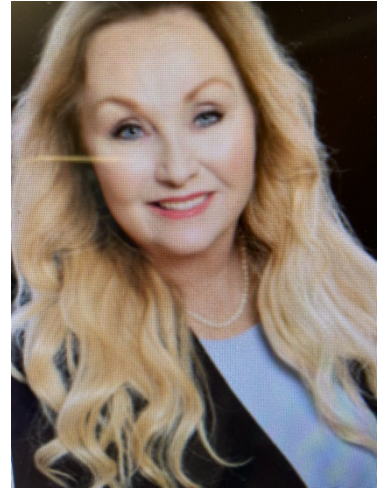

INGREDIENTS

- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1/2 yellow onion, chopped
- 1 1/2 Tablespoons taco seasoning
- 1 head lettuce or about 6 cups chopped mixed lettuces
- 4 tomatoes, chopped
- 2 avocados, chopped
- 15 oz. can kidney beans, rinsed and drained
- 2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1 large bag Doritos or Fritos

FOR THE DRESSING:

- 3/4 cup Miracle Whip
- 1/4 cup sour cream
- 1 Tablespoon sugar
- Juice of 1 lime
- 1 Tablespoon taco seasoning
- 1-2 teaspoons Tabasco sauce, to taste

DORITOS TACO SALAD

Prep Time: 10 minutes

Cook Time: 10 minutes

Total Time: 20 minutes

Total Servings: 8

COOKING

1. In a skillet over medium heat, combine the ground beef and onions. Sauté until beef is browned and onions are softened. Sprinkle with taco seasoning and salt and pepper to taste (if needed). Remove from heat.
2. Meanwhile, prepare the dressing. Whisk together Miracle Whip, sour cream, taco seasoning, sugar, and hot sauce.
3. In a bowl, combine the lettuce, avocado, tomato, beans, cheese, beef mixture, and chips.
4. Add the dressing and stir together until combined. Serve immediately.
