

ST. JOHN SCHOOL PARENT-STUDENT HANDBOOK
HOME / SCHOOL CONTRACT

As required by the Diocese of Baton Rouge, "Parents who seek a Catholic education for their child/children enter into a contractual agreement between the school and the parent/guardian and/or the rules of the school covering all areas of the student's development as stated in the school's philosophy. As part of the contractual agreement there are explicit (expressed) and implicit (implied) expectations placed on both parent and administration. These rules and regulations are included in the parent-student handbook and school communications."

Catholic schools operate under contract law. The handbook is the printed contract between the parents of minor students and the school or between the adult student and the school. It is required that parent/guardian and their child sign a statement that they and their child agree to abide by the policies, rules, and regulations set forth therein. By signing this statement, parents and students agree to be governed by the rules and regulations stated in the handbook. Failure to abide by the regulations and policies of the school handbook by either the student or his/her parent/guardian may result in the student's removal from the school.

In developing the rules and policies for St. John School, both the Administration and the Advisory Board have tried to anticipate as many circumstances and problems as possible. As new and unusual situations arise, the administration will have the authority to use their discretion in whatever circumstances the handbook rules do not precisely address. The administration also reserve the right to amend the handbook, if they feel it is necessary. The following is a parental agreement stating you have read the St. John Parent-Student Handbook and you agree to be governed by the rules and regulations stated in the handbook.

As a parent/guardian, I have read the St. John Parent-Student Handbook and understand that I must cooperate with the school and adhere to the policies, procedures, and regulations contained in the policy handbook. I also understand that I am accountable for all the policies and regulations contained therein, including the policies and procedures listed in Technology Acceptable Use Policy. I further understand that for the good of the entire school community, the St. John School Administration may, from time to time, deem it necessary to establish special requirements regarding my child's continued enrollment at St. John School. I further understand and acknowledge that re-enrollment and re-admission decisions are made on a year-to-year basis, and my child's re-enrollment for the next school year or any future school year is not guaranteed. I agree to abide by these decisions. This agreement must be signed by both parents/legal guardians with whom the student resides.

INTERNET ACCESS/ACCEPTABLE USE AGREEMENT

ALL PARENTS AND STUDENTS MUST READ CAREFULLY, SIGN, AND RETURN TO SCHOOL OFFICE.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

St. John School provides access to the Internet for all students. Our goal in providing this service is to provide opportunities for research, creativity, and communication. With access to information from all over the world also comes the availability of material that may not be appropriate for use in the school environment. St. John School has instituted certain precautions through supervised access and in compliance with the *Children's Internet Protection Act (CHIP)*. However, on a global network it is impossible to control all materials and a persistent student may discover controversial information. The school firmly believes that the valuable information and interaction available on this global network far outweighs the possibility that users may procure material that is not consistent with the educational goals of the school.

In order for a student to use the Internet connection, they must read the acceptable use guidelines and sign the contract. The contract must also be signed by a parent/guardian. Only students with this contract on file will be allowed to utilize the Internet connection provided through the school.

In addition, students/parents acknowledge that they understand the Acceptable Use Policy may apply to online behaviors that originate anywhere, including from private internet connections and devices. Students and parents found engaging in online bullying, harassment, illegal activities, or any other online conduct that may be detrimental to the school (as determined by the school administration) may be subject to consequences at school as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook.

I release the school and related organizations from any liability relating to consequences resulting from my use of the Internet.
