

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS, DECLARING CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING ITS SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OR OTHER LAWFUL MEANS

WHEREAS, the City of Bull Shoals owns a former police vehicle commonly known as the "Crown Victoria" police vehicle, which is no longer required for municipal operations and has been removed from active service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that retention of said vehicle is no longer necessary for the conduct of municipal business and that disposal of the vehicle is in the best interests of the City and its taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide a fair and transparent method for the disposition of surplus municipal property in accordance with Arkansas law and City policy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that offering the vehicle for sale through a public process provides an opportunity for City residents, taxpayers, employees, and the general public to participate in the purchase of surplus property and ensures that the City receives reasonable value for the asset.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Declaration of Surplus Property.

The following municipal property is hereby declared surplus property:

- One (1) Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor
- VIN: 2FABP7BV5AX132427
- Model Year: 2010
- Mileage: 155180

Section 2. Authorization to Sell.

The Mayor and City Recorder are authorized to dispose of the above-described vehicle by one of the following methods:

1. Public auction;
2. Sealed bid sale;
3. Online government surplus auction;
4. Sale to a City employee, provided such sale is conducted in accordance with applicable Arkansas law, City policy, and at not less than fair market value; or

5. Any other lawful method approved by the City Council.

Section 3. Public Notice.

Prior to any sale, reasonable public notice shall be provided to afford City taxpayers and members of the public an equal opportunity to purchase the vehicle through the authorized sale process.

Section 4. Acceptance of Bid or Offer.

The Mayor is authorized to accept the highest responsible bid or offer determined to be in the best interest of the City, provided the sale price is deemed reasonable based upon the vehicle's condition and fair market value.

Section 5. Deposit of Proceeds.

All proceeds from the sale shall be deposited into the appropriate City fund and accounted for in accordance with municipal financial procedures.

Section 6. Severability.

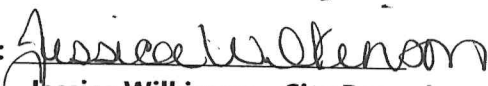
Should any section or provision of this Resolution be declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Resolution.
