A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE CITY MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN OF THE CITY OF BULL SHOALS, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the City of Bull Shoals, Marion County, Arkansas requests the City Council to appoint the Maintenance Technician for all departments of the City of Bull Shoals; and

WHEREAS the City of Bull Shoals would benefit by having a full-time mechanic that can work on all department equipment such as oil changes, greasing, brake repair, cleaning equipment, setting up routine maintenance schedules, etc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BULL SHOALS, MARION COUNTY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

- 1) Jamie L. Rogers is hereby appointed as Bull Shoals City Maintenance Technician. This appointment will take effect starting June 22nd, 2026, upon passage by a 2/3rds majority vote of the City Council.
- 2) It will take a 2/3rds majority vote of the City Council of the City of Bull Shoals to remove Jamie L. Rogers as the Bull Shoals Maintenance Technician.
- 3) The wage of this position shall be \$20.00 per hour.

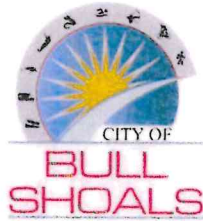
This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

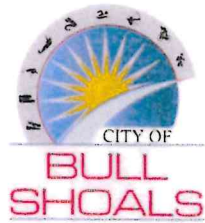
Mayor and Public Works Director

Job Overview

Must be 18 years of age. Maintain vehicles and equipment. Candidate should have a solid understanding of several types of engines, parts, and systems. Will coordinate with Streets, Water and Sewer Departments when they need assistance. Work with the Public Works Director on things that need to be completed in the city.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Inspect vehicles and equipment for damage or issues.
- Perform routine maintenance tasks, such as oil changes, tire rotations, and fluid top-offs.
- Diagnosing and repairing mechanical, electrical, and electronic malfunctions.
- Replacing and repairing damaged parts and components.
- Testing vehicles and equipment to ensure they are functioning properly.
- Keep detailed records of maintenance performed.
- Communication with other drivers and other team members to identify and address maintenance needs.
- Maintain a clean and organized work area.
- Comply with safety regulations and procedures.
- Maintain a positive and professional attitude.
- Mow city streets and other areas with mower or tractor.
- Cleaning out street ditches and opening clogged culverts.
- Removing waste materials such as rocks, stumps, trash, leaves, dead animals, etc.
- Operating dump truck, jack hammer, filling potholes, chain saw, cutting torch, snowplow, etc.
