- 3. How has the nominee trained and mentored others and encouraged more women into the industry?
- 4. Describe their commitment and future aspirations within the construction, building or infrastructure industries.
- 5. What exceptional qualities sets them apart from others in the workplace?
- 6. Share any other activities they are involved in with others in the industry and outside the workplace and wider community.
