Our Curriculum:

English:

Book Focus: Tiddler, Dear Zoo.

- Write short sentences using capital letters and full stops.
- Use sounds to help spell words.
- Say ideas out loud before writing.
- Read our writing to check it makes sense.
- Form letters correctly.

Phonics:

The children will:

- Learn the sounds and spellings: **q, u, ve, tch**.
- Practise reading and writing words with these sounds.
- Explore different spellings for the sounds **/k/, /ch/, /w/** and **/v/**.
- Build confidence ready for learning the extended code in Year 1.

Maths:

The children will:

- Share and group objects in different ways.
- Build and describe shapes and models.
- Explore maps, positions and spatial language.
- Make connections between numbers, shapes and patterns.

RE:

What makes a place special?

- Learn about churches, mosques and temples.
- Talk about why places are special to people.
- Learn how people show respect in places of worship.

How do people celebrate special times?

- Learn about Pentecost and other celebrations.
- Explore how festivals bring people together and create memories.

Understanding the world:

Understanding the world (ELGs)

- Talk about holidays and travel in the past.
- Compare holidays now and long ago.
- Learn about planes, travel and people's jobs.
- Use stories and pictures to understand the past.

Science (Understanding the World)

Under the Sea!

- Learn about sea habitats and animals.
- Compare different environments.
- Explore how to care for oceans and living things.
- Ask questions and make observations.

Music

- Listen and move to funk music.
- Keep a steady beat and copy rhythms.
- Sing songs and play instruments together.
- Explore high and low sounds.

- Draw, paint, cut and build with increasing control.
- Use tools safely and carefully.
- Develop hand strength and coordination.
- Work independently in creative activities.

Computing

Introduction to data

- Sort and group objects.
- Create simple pictograms.
- Explore branch databases through games.

PE

Ball skills

- Roll, throw, catch and kick balls.
- Practise control and coordination in games.
- Work with others to develop ball skills.

PSHE

- Learn how people, animals and plants grow.
- Talk about stages from baby to adult.
- Explore simple life cycles.
