

## Joint RuminOmics/Rumen Microbial Genomics Network /ECO-FCE Workshop

The EU Framework 7 project <u>RuminOmics</u> is organising a satellite workshop, together with the <u>Rumen Microbial Genomics Network</u> and the analogous FP7 project on non-ruminant species, <u>ECO-FCE</u>, on the day preceding the main Rowett-INRA2014, <u>Gut Microbiology</u>: from <u>Sequence to Function</u> conference.

The aim of the workshop will be to compare and contrast methodologies, results and problems from the different projects, with the theme: *How does the gut microbiota influence feed efficiency?* 

You are invited to join the workshop and to contribute your thoughts on these and related matters.
