The Co-op Funeral Home is a not-for-profit funeral home, serving the Greater Seattle area with dignified and affordable burial, cremation, aquamation, and terramation (natural organic reduction) arrangements.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. The 1984 Funeral Rule is a federal law that protects your right to choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement provided to you that describes the funeral goods and services you selected.

All packaged plans listed include:

- Basic services of funeral director & staff;
- Receiving and transporting the deceased at any hour of the day or night within our 30-mile service area;
- Sheltering and refrigeration of remains for up to 10 days; and,
- Optional Obituary posted on The Co-op Funeral Home website

All packaged plans listed do <u>not</u> Include:

- King County sales tax;
- \$100 King County Medical Examiner tax (for King County deaths only);
- \$15 Snohomish County filing fee (for Snohomish County deaths only);
- \$25 Pierce County filing fee (for Pierce County deaths only);
- Transportation outside our 30-mile service area;
- Ferry or bridge tolls;
- Flowers;
- Newspaper obituaries;
- Honoraria for clergy, celebrants or musicians;
- Cost of certified copies of the death certificate (\$25) or other cash advance items.

How to use this General Price List

Everyone's lives are distinctly unique, and we pride ourselves on offering every disposition method and most keepsake options available today. Our customers are welcome to pick a basic package that best suits their needs, but should additional services be desired, there are available add-on options beginning on page 8.

Customers may also build their own package from the itemized goods and services, however any custom packages will need to include our non-declinable Basic Services Fee, which is the first item listed In the Itemized Goods & Services section on page 8.

"PMA Pricing" is the price offered to members of People's Memorial Association (PMA). "Standard Pricing" is offered to those who do not wish to enroll in a PMA Membership. Membership is not required to use our funeral home's services.

A membership to the non-profit People's Memorial Association is a one-time fee of \$99 per person and helps support their education and advocacy work for funeral consumers in Washington State. Members of PMA receive a 15% discount off of the cost of funeral goods and services.

Cremation & Aquamation

Cremation is a method of disposition by which flame reduces our body down to its most basic elements. All that remains at the end are bone fragments that are then processed into "ashes." This is the most common form of final disposition chosen by Washingtonians.

Our direct cremation packages include a legally required alternative container in place of a casket. Alternative containers encase the body before cremation and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composite materials. The alternative containers we provide have a shallow fiberboard bottom and deeper cardboard top.

Aquamation, otherwise known as alkaline hydrolysis, is a more environmentally-friendly alternative to flame-based cremation. This process uses pressurized water and a small amount of alkaline chemicals to break down our body's organic matter. The bones that remain at the end are processed into a fine powder, much like cremated remains.

Our direct cremation and aquamation packages include a simple, black plastic urn to hold the remains after cremation or aquamation takes place. This gives you the opportunity to take your time to find something really special, or to opt out of choosing another container altogether. Many people who choose to scatter will do the latter.

Same as a direct aquamation with the addition of a private viewing at our care facility in Kent, WA for up to 1 hour. This is not a viewing open to the public, rather a simple viewing with minimal preparation of the decedent for the next-of-kin. This does not include embalming or dressing, but these are optional items that can be added if you choose.

Terramation

Terramation, otherwise known as natural organic reduction, is a relatively new process for final disposition. The process gently transforms human remains into life-giving soil. A body is laid in with a mixture of alfalfa, straw, and sawdust, and just like any other compost is given plenty of air flow to allow the organic matter to naturally break down over the course of 30 - 90 days. At the end of the process, the next-of-kin is able to receive the nutrient-rich bags of soil. You may choose any amount of soil you would like - the end result yields one cubic yard of soil. Should you choose not to receive the entire amount of composted remains, you can donate the soil to be scattered on a piece of land in need of revitalization. This land is maintained by our partners at Return Home in Auburn, WA.

Same as a direct terramation with the addition of 2 hours usage of the Return Home facility for a gathering and in-person goodbye. This viewing can accommodate up to 50-60 people with the next-of-kin being able to place personal, organic materials in the container to be gently transformed into compost along with the decedent.

Burial Plans

One of the oldest forms of final disposition, burial can have a wide variety of options and service types, including but not limited to: embalming, green burial, shrouding or casketing. At The Co-op Funeral Home we are proud to be able to meet the needs of our clients' spiritual, ceremonial, and ethical values when it comes to the burial of their next-of-kin.

To learn more about how each burial plan can be adapted for green burial, see page 14. If your loved one was a veteran, our funeral directors are happy to help coordinate an array of veteran benefits from burial at a national cemetery to military honors for a graveside or memorial service.

Please be aware you will need to select the cemetery of your choice, which will have its own separate service charges and fees.

Burial date and time will be coordinated with the cemetery at the funeral home's convenience without next-of-kin present for the burial. Does <u>not</u> include bathing or dressing services.

Burial with a Graveside Service\$3,275\$3,850

This plan includes a basic casket, placement of remains in the casket, and delivery of casketed remains Monday through Friday between 9 am and 5 pm to a cemetery within our 30-mile service radius. Specific burial date and time will be coordinated with the cemetery, with the next-of-kin present for a graveside service or witnessed burial. Bathing and Dressing services available for an additional cost (see section, *Preparation of Your Loved One* on page 10).

Funeral Service Plans

The following funeral service plans <u>do not include the cost for a graveside service</u>. For graveside services, expect some additional charges from both our funeral home and the cemetery. These plans are meant to be open-ended, allowing you to choose either cremation, burial, or alkaline hydrolysis to follow your service. Full Mortuary Service at Your Own Venue\$3,935\$4,630

This plan includes a basic casket and the following services: embalming, dressing and placement of remains in casket, use of staff for funeral at your house of worship or event venue Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm, transportation by van, handling of flowers. This plan does <u>not</u> include clergy/officiant or flowers, cremation or graveside following the service. A credit equal to the cost of the basic casket will be applied if you prefer to upgrade the casket.

Add-ons for Funeral Service Plans

Graveside Service or Witnessed Burial\$480\$565This fee includes a Funeral Director for a graveside service or witnessed burial following
the funeral service. Funeral home staff are required to remain at the cemetery until
family has departed and the transfer of custody of remains is completed.

Caring for Infants and Children

If you have experienced the loss of a child under 18, they do not need their own membership to qualify for the membership discount. Membership pricing can be accepted as long as a parent, guardian, or grandparent is a member of People's Memorial.

\$500 **Child Cremation** \$500 If you've experienced the loss of someone aged 0-to-17-years-old. Includes basic overhead charges of funeral director and staff, transportation to bring your loved one into our care, cremation, and a plastic urn.

Child Aquamation \$1,100 \$1.295 If you've experienced the loss of someone under the age of 0-to-17-years-old. Includes basic overhead charges of funeral director and staff, transportation to bring your loved one into our care, aquamation, and a plastic urn.

Child Terramation \$1.415 Return Home graciously donates their terramation services (including a laying in ceremony) at no cost for any deaths of a person under age 18. Costs above include our basic needs to cover overhead costs for The Co-op's staff time & transportation.

Transfer of tissue from hospital \$215

We provide transfer services for surgically removed tissue from hospitals to families. Since hospitals must release such tissue through licensed funeral homes, we can arrange pickup and return it to you at minimal cost. Please notify us in advance of the surgery. Pickup of tissue must happen at our office in Queen Anne; no delivery.

Hearse

Funeral Procession or Motorcade

This is a cash advance service and has a minimum of three motorcycles or motorized vehicles. Details and coordination will be communicated by the Funeral Director.

Embalming may also be necessary if the body is going to be traveling a long distance and cold storage is not feasible, or to a destination requiring embalming for transport. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or direct burial.

Embalming is not required by law, though it is recommended for certain funeral

Preparation of Your Loved One

In the event that the decedent has had an autopsy and the next-of-kin requests a viewing, it is recommended that the care facility be allowed to prepare your loved one. These preparations would be non-invasive and do not include embalming.

Bathing & Dressing

Includes basic sanitation and dressing of your loved one. This is included in all full mortuary service funeral packages, and can be added on to all other other packages such as viewings, cremations, or direct burials. If you're interested in dressing before an aquamation, please consult your funeral director. This does not include cosmetology. Clothing will need to be provided to your funeral director 3 full business days prior to the date of service.

Fingerprints

Fingerprints can be collected on an index card to be kept for sentiment or used for various types of jewelry and keepsakes. Fingerprints may not always be possible. Availability pending assessment of your loved one's condition.

Locks of Hair

Our staff will do their best to collect locks of hair. Outcomes are dependent on the length and condition of your loved one's hair.

Major Restorations

Major restorations are costs added to existing embalming and care costs. They generally start around \$500 with additional costs determined on a case by case basis. If this service is needed, your funeral director can consult with a restoration artist to determine a more accurate estimate.

Cosmetology

Hair and makeup by a licensed cosmetologist. The funeral home will coordinate and communicate instructions on behalf of next-of-kin. Services rendered will be included on the final invoice. While not necessary, next-of-kin may provide makeup, hair supplies, and photographs to assist the cosmetologist with matching features and complexion.

Once the cremation or aquamation has begun, all parties must take their leave and will receive final remains from The Co-op Funeral Home at a later date.

This includes our basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home, refrigeration for up to 10 days, filing of death certificate, and local transportation to a cemetery. This does <u>not</u> include a casket, graveside service, or witnessed burial. Before purchasing your own casket, please consult with your cemetery for size requirements, and your funeral director for proper shipping address and instructions.

We can arrange for green burial at the natural burial ground or cemetery of your choice. Direct Burial and Graveside plans can be handled as green burials with a cloth shroud substituted for the casket at no extra cost. We also offer other green burial options including wicker or seagrass caskets, as well as a basic wood casket.
