A Blessing for Bridgetown's Students

This summer marked the 2nd Annual Back-to-School Drive in Bridgetown, Barbados, a powerful outreach that brought hope, joy, and provision to hundreds of children preparing for a new school year.

Through the generous contributions of churches, missionaries, and members from across the Mid-Atlantic Episcopal District, more than 600 bookbags filled with school supplies were donated and distributed to children throughout the community.

"We are grateful for the overwhelming generosity that poured out from our episcopal area," said Pastor Richardson. "Together, we not only met the needs of the children, we reminded them that they are seen, supported, and loved."

A United Effort: Living the Kingdom Mindset
