World Mission Sunday (Sunday, October 19, 2025)

"In 1926 Pope Pius XI instituted Missions Sunday for the whole Church with the first Worldwide Mission Sunday Collection taking place in October of 1927. The Mission Sunday Collection is always taken on the next to last Sunday during the month of October. That day is celebrated in all the local Churches as the feast of catholicity and universal solidarity so Christians all over the world will recognize their common responsibility with regard to evangelization".

There will be a special Bilingual Mass to celebrate World Mission Sunday. **The Mass will be held in the parish center on Sunday, October 19th at 1:30 pm.** We will start with a procession at the church ending in the parish center. We will pray the rosary at the end of the procession.

Everyone is invited to come and wear their special t-shirt representing a continent.

Africa-Green, for the forests and grasslands of Africa.

Oceania- Blue, for the ocean surrounding the Islands of the Pacific.

Europe-White, symbolizing Europe, the seat of the Holy Father, shepherd of the World.

America-Red, calling to mind the fire of faith that brought missionaries to the Americas.

Asia-Yellow, Eastern morning light.

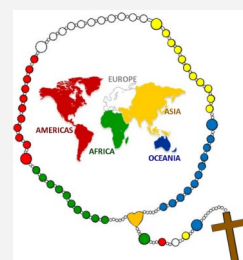

Domingo Mundial de Las Misiones (Domingo, 19 de Octubre 2025)

“En 1926, el Papa Pío XI instituyó el Domingo de las Misiones para toda la Iglesia y la primera Colecta Mundial del Domingo de las Misiones tuvo lugar en octubre de 1927. La Colecta del Domingo Mundial de las Misiones siempre se realiza el penúltimo domingo durante el mes de octubre. Ese día se celebra en todas las Iglesias locales como fiesta de la catolicidad y de la solidaridad universal, para que los cristianos de todo el mundo reconozcan su responsabilidad común en la evangelización”.

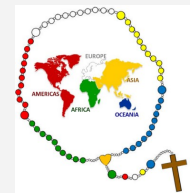
