## YARNTON PARISH COUNCIL CEMETERY

### TABLE OF FEES from 1<sup>st</sup> APRIL 2026

FEES, PAYMENTS and SUMS fixed and settled under the Local Authorities Order 1977 Section 15

#### Interment Fees:

Child up to 16 years of age (including stillborn)	No charge
Over 16 years of age	£350.00
Internment of Ashes	£200.00

#### Exclusive right of Burial in Earthen Grave:

For the exclusive right of burial (for 99 years) in children's section	£125.00
For the exclusive right of burial (for 50 years)	£410.00
For the exclusive right of burial of cremated remains (for 50 years)	£200.00

#### Monuments and Inscriptions:

Headstones, where the exclusive right of burial has been granted	£140.00
Any additional inscription	£105.00

(Prices include right to install a memorial for 25 years [renewable])

#### Fees for Reserving Burial Plots:

Plots will only be able to be reserved next to close relatives (eg Parent, Spouse, child etc), the full payment for "Exclusive right of Burial" will be charged, in addition to the appropriate burial fee at time of burial in the reserved plot. On payment of the "Exclusive right of burial" fee the "Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial" form and letter will be issued. Subsequent burials in the reserved plots will be charged at the appropriate fee.

#### Notes:

The Burial Ground is limited and is reserved for residents or previous residents of Yarnton, and people with a strong link to the village. The above charges will be doubled where the person is not an inhabitant of Yarnton, or hasn't lived in the village within the last 3 years, except when moved directly from the village into a residential care home or similar. Burials take place in the extension which is un-consecrated and limited to single burials. Spaces remaining in the original burial ground will be kept for people specifically requesting burials in consecrated ground and/or for people requesting double graves. Interment fees will be waived for Parish Councillor's (current and past) who have served at least four years or who have died whilst being an existing Parish Councillor (minute page 2/2019)
