- A. The Parish Council is **NOT** responsible for the digging of graves. All surplus soil **MUST** be removed from site.
- B. A Certificate of Disposal or Coroner's Order for Burial must be delivered to the person effecting the disposal of the body.
- C. This notice is to be delivered to the Clerk of the Council, Yarnton Parish Council, Yarnton Village Hall, The Paddocks, Yarnton, Kidlington, Oxon, OX5 1TE clerk@yarnton-pc.gov.uk at least 48 hours previous to any interment in any grave.
- D. BACS payments are to be made to: Unity Trust Bank – Account name: Yarnton Parish Council, Sort Code: 60-83-01, Account No: 20413826
- E. The Exclusive right of burial to be purchased is for 50 years initially, after which time it is anticipated that the period will be able to be extended.
- F. The Rector of St Bartholomew's Church, Yarnton has no jurisdiction over Yarnton Cemetery and **ALL** requests for Burial **MUST** come through to the Parish Council.
- G. *The person registered on the Deeds will only be contacted in regards to matters relating to the grave or cemetery.
