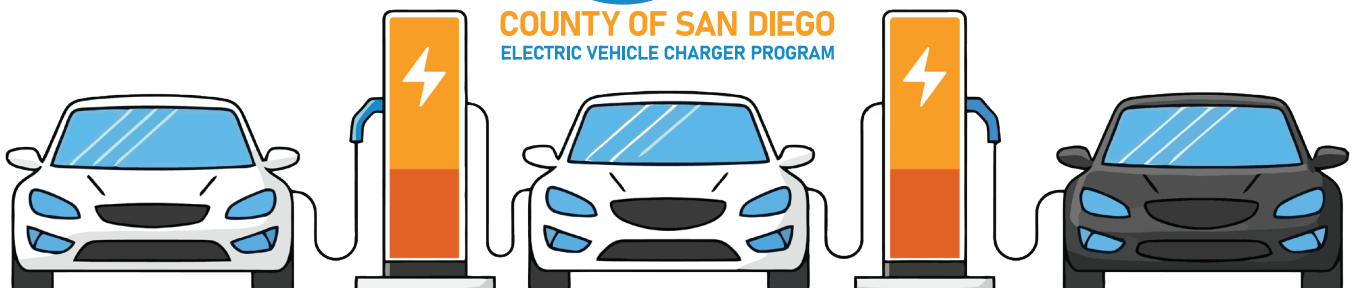
Electric Vehicle Charger Installation Incentives Available!

The County of San Diego is offering rebates to help install **publicly accessible electric vehicle (EV) chargers** in unincorporated areas in San Diego County. This program seeks to expand reliable charging access, accelerate the transition to electric vehicles, and advance goals outlined in the County's Climate Action Plan.

Eligible applicants—including property owners, businesses, nonprofits, multifamily housing operators, EV installers, and others—may receive funding to install publicly accessible EV chargers, helping expand reliable charging access and accelerate the transition to clean transportation.

Publicly accessible chargers must be available for general public charging for 18-24 hours per day.

Funding will be distributed in multiple rounds, with eligible applications selected through a lottery at the end of each application period.



The Details

Equity Priority Area Funding

50% of all project funds are reserved for projects in Equity Priority Areas. Visit the EVCP website to see if your site applies.

Round 1 Incentives Available:

Level 2 Chargers:

- Up to **\$5,000** per charger
- **+\$1,000** for Equity Priority Areas
- Maximum **\$30,000** per site, increases to \$36,000 for Equity Priority Areas

DC Fast Chargers:

- Up to **\$75,000** per charger
- Up to **\$10,000** for Equity Priority Areas
- Maximum **\$225,000**, increases to \$255,000 for Equity Priority Areas

Who Can Apply?

- Property owners, businesses, nonprofits, and multifamily housing operators
- **Properties must be within unincorporated San Diego County**

Key Project Requirements

- Public access **18+ hours/day** (except multifamily)
- **New networked EV charging equipment**
- Installation by **EVITP-Certified Electricians**
- **Chargers must remain operational for at least 6 years**

How to Apply

Submit an application through the **program website**. Approved projects must be completed within: **270 days** for **Level 2** chargers and **450 days** for **DC Fast Chargers**. See website for more information on application window dates.
