Join us for Louisville's **Fifth Annual TreeFest** - a citywide Arbor Day celebration on **April 11, 2026** at **Thurman-Hutchins Park**! This day-long event brings together over 1,000 residents for a volunteer tree planting, live music, food, kids' activities, educational exhibits, and more.

Louisville's most recent Urban Tree Canopy Assessment shows a 1% increase in canopy coverage between 2012 and 2019 - a meaningful shift considering earlier projections predicted significant decline. This growth reflects the impact of community-wide efforts and public education initiatives led by TreesLouisville and our partners.
