### **Reading 1 - Isaiah 66:18-21**

Thus says the LORD: I know their works and their thoughts, and I come to gather nations of every language; they shall come and see my glory. I will set a sign among them; from them I will send fugitives to the nations: to Tarshish, Put and Lud, Mosoch, Tubal and Javan, to the distant coastlands that have never heard of my fame, or seen my glory; and they shall proclaim my glory among the nations. They shall bring all your brothers and sisters from all the nations as an offering to the LORD, on horses and in chariots, in carts, upon mules and dromedaries, to Jerusalem, my holy mountain, says the LORD, just as the Israelites bring their offering to the house of the LORD in clean vessels. Some of these I will take as priests and Levites, says the LORD.

### **Responsorial Psalm - Psalm 117:1, 2**

Go out to all the world and tell the Good News.

### **Reading 2 - Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13**

Brothers and sisters, You have forgotten the exhortation addressed to you as children: "My son, do not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reproved by him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines; he scourges every son he acknowledges." Endure your trials as "discipline"; God treats you as sons. For what "son" is there whom his father does not discipline? At the time, all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it. So strengthen your drooping hands and your weak knees. Make straight paths for your feet, that what is lame may not be disjointed but healed.

### **Gospel - Luke 13:22-30**

Jesus passed through towns and villages, teaching as he went and making his way to Jerusalem. Someone asked him, "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" He answered them, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough. After the master of the house has arisen and locked the door, then will you stand outside knocking and saying, 'Lord, open the door for us.' He will say to you in reply, 'I do not know where you are from. And you will say, 'We ate and drank in your company and you taught in our streets.' Then he will say to you, 'I do not know where you are from. Depart from me, all you evildoers!' And there will be wailing and grinding of teeth when you see Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God and you yourselves cast out. And people will come from the east and the west and from the north and the south and will recline at table in the kingdom of God. For behold, some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last."

**I believe in one God**, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven: and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and His kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come.

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits, who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

**LIVING AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES**

Our scripture passage for this Sunday comes from the Gospel of Luke 13:22-30. In this scene, someone poses a question of faith that manifests his or her religious curiosity. The person who posed the question to Jesus was someone who heard Jesus as our Lord made His way to Jerusalem. The person addresses Jesus with the title "Lord" which indicates that the person was favorably disposed to Jesus and may have even been a disciple. Their question reflects the religious curiosity of someone who is exploring the details of faith and discipleship. It also reflects the curiosity that seeks ever-greater knowledge and can even become an unhealthy pursuit of religious trivia. Sometimes it's possible for a person to become infatuated or distracted with religious things while being deterred from a committed relationship with the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus does not answer the man's question. Rather, our Lord redirects his attention to actively trying to live out discipleship. This interchange invites us to reflect on the nature of discipleship and what it means to be a person of faith. Faith is not just a matter of knowing more but of our ability and willingness to act on our knowledge and pursue a transformed life (repentance). No one has ever been declared a Saint (canonized) because of what they knew but because of how they lived. Such transformation is an ongoing challenge in a Christian's life. If a person is not striving for holiness each day, then they have become complacent in their discipleship. Following Jesus requires more than just knowledge of religious information; following Jesus involves a transformation of life.

**Think about it:** What aspect of my faith do I find difficult to live out in practice?
