First Reading – Isaiah 56:1, 6-7

Thus says the LORD: Observe what is right, do what is just; for my salvation is about to come, my justice, about to be revealed. The foreigners who join themselves to the LORD, ministering to him, loving the name of the LORD, and becoming his servants — all who keep the sabbath free from profanation and hold to my covenant, them I will bring to my holy mountain and make joyful in my house of prayer; their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be acceptable on my altar, for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples.

Second Reading – Romans 11:13-15, 29-32

Brothers and sisters: I am speaking to you Gentiles. inasmuch as I am the apostle to the Gentiles, I glory in my ministry in order to make my race jealous and thus save some of them. For if their rejection is the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?

For the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable. Just as you once disobeyed God but have now received mercy because of their disobedience, so they have now disobeyed in order that, by virtue of the mercy shown to you, they too may now receive mercy. For God delivered all to disobedience, that he might have mercy upon all.

Gospel – Matthew 15:21-28

At that time, Jesus withdrew to the region of Tyre and Sidon. And behold, a Canaanite woman of that district came and called out, "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David! My daughter is tormented by a demon." But Jesus did not say a word in answer to her.

Jesus' disciples came and asked him, "Send her away, for she keeps calling out after us."

He said in reply, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."

But the woman came and did Jesus homage, saying, "Lord, help me."

He said in reply, "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs."

She said, "Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters."

Then Jesus said to her in reply, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish." And the woman's daughter was healed from that hour.

The Nicene Creed

LIVING AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES

Our Scripture passage for this Sunday comes from the Gospel of Matthew 14:22-33. It is the story of Jesus walking on the water towards the disciples in the boat and of Peter's faltering faith that causes him to sink into the stormy waves. It is significant that the Gospel tells us Jesus took time to pray while the disciples were in the boat. This is the first time in Matthew's Gospel that we read about Jesus praying. While we do not know the content of our Lord's prayer at this moment, it is apparent that His prayer prepares Him for what is about to take place. Jesus is preparing to reveal Himself as the presence of God to the disciples. The Lord's prayer prepares Him for this revelation by establishing communion with the Father. The disciples were not at prayer, and so their absence of communion left them frightened, feeling alone, and doubting our Lord's revelation. The prayer of Jesus was not a brief experience. Rather, it was an extensive time that lasted all night until the fourth watch (between 3:00 and 6:00 a.m.). As the disciples are entering more deeply into fear, Jesus is entering more deeply into communion with the Father and clarity of His identity as the great I AM. This insight into the effect of prayer should inspire and motivate us as disciples to seek prolonged communion with God, especially when we feel distanced and facing the storms of life. Our Lord's prayer lasted for hours and that, too, is instructive for us that we should not expect immediate results for our efforts. Prayer is not so much about giving God our grocery list of needs as it is about being drawn into the Divine Presence and being conformed to the Divine Will. Ultimately, we are told the content of Jesus' prayer is when He prays in the Garden of Gethsemane. Our Lord makes it clear that prayer is not about convincing God to do our will but about motivating us to do the Father's will.

Think about it: How can I deepen my prayer life and learn to pray in new and more profound way.
