

PAYMENT POLICY

Losing someone deeply loved can be a devastating and often challenging experience. Therefore, it is important to be realistic with respect to funeral expenditures. Important decisions should reflect personal wishes and remain within budget. The payment policy listed below allows us to serve at our utmost.

CASH ADVANCE ITEMS

Cash advance items are charges to others necessary to conduct our services. Such charges represent a cash outlay, without a profit being realized by Walker Funeral & Cremation Service. Therefore, payment for such advances is required at the time of the arrangement conference. Such charges will be reflected on the itemized statement of goods and services.

PAYMENT POLICY – TOTAL FUNERAL BILL

Cash or Check - The charges for our services and merchandise shown on the statement of funeral goods and services selected are due prior to the service. The prices on this price list represent a 3.5% cash or check discount.

Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover - For your convenience, these credit cards are accepted for payment in full at the time of arrangements, however the prices charged, including cash advances, will be charged without the 3.5% cash or check discount.

Valid Insurance Assignment - When it is possible to determine that a valid insurance policy exists that will cover the total funeral expenses, such policy will be accepted as payment ONLY with the completion of a valid insurance assignment and the acceptance of such by the company issuing the policy. Amounts payable by insurance, including cash advances, will be charged a 4% insurance filing fee.

We regret that we are not able to accept payments by estate or probate. In all cases where total payment has not been received by the due date, a late payment charge of 1¼% per month (15% per annum) will be assessed on the unpaid balance.

SIGNED CONTRACT REQUIRED

It is our policy to not extend services or provide merchandise of any nature (except removal of the body from the place of death) unless a family member or other responsible party having the right to do so, signs a contract authorizing the firm to act according to those desires.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF AND OVERHEAD	\$ 2,495
<i>Our services include: 24/7/365 on call service; conducting the arrangement conference; planning of funeral or memorial ceremonies; consulting with family and clergy; preparing and filing of necessary notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; all administrative duties; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)</i>	
TRANSFER OF REMAINS TO THE FUNERAL HOME (within 25-mile radius)	\$ 550
<i>Beyond this radius we charge \$4 per mile.</i>	
EMBALMING	\$ 750
<i>Except in certain special cases embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.</i>

DIRECT CREMATION	\$ 2,495 to \$ 11,970
<i>Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains; refrigeration; transportation to crematory; necessary authorizations and the cremation process. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are a fiberboard container or an unfinished wood box. This does not include the Medical Examiner’s Cremation permit fee and crematory fee.</i>

The Oklahoma Medical Examiner’s Office assesses a \$235 cremation permit fee for cremation when death occurs in Oklahoma. Cremation will not occur until the permit has been issued by their office. The crematory fee is \$335.
