TRAVEL

Bus:

Buses operate outside the Tramway pub to Southwold, Lowestoft and beyond

TURNING LEFT OUT OF THE HOTEL

By car, Pakefield roundabout is 3 minutes, Kessingland is 10 minutes, Oulton Broad is 15 minutes, Southwold is 22 minutes.

WALKING:

Turning left out of the hotel Pakefield roundabout with all the below facilities is a 10-15 minute walk.

FOOD SHOPPING:

Morrisons Supermarket, Pakefield, is 5 minutes by car and has got everything you should need including free cash point, ready meals, essentials, toiletries, alcohol, snacks and gifts.

Sainsbury's Supermarket, opposite Morrisons, is brand new to the town so gives you a choice of large supermarkets with a decent selection of quality ready meals.

World of Fish - is a traditional fishmongers and has an incredible selection of fresh and smoked fish as well as a great shellfish selection. Closed Sunday and Monday.

TURNING RIGHT OUT OF THE HOTEL

By car, Pakefield Cliffs are 3 minutes, Kirkley is 5 minutes, Lowestoft beachfront is 10 minutes, Gorleston seafront is 18 minutes, Great Yarmouth is 25 minutes.

WALKING:

Pakefield centre is 3 minutes, Pakefield cliffs are 10 minutes, Kirkley is 15 minutes, Lowestoft beach is 20 minutes.

FOOD SHOPPING:

Co-op Supermarket, Pakefield has a good range of ready meals, free cash point, essentials, toiletries, alcohol, snacks and gifts.

Kirkley High Street has another **Co-op** and Lowestoft Town Centre has an array of shops.

FAST FOOD:

Mr Chips - A 3-minute walk - serves excellent kebabs, burgers and fried fish & chips.

Pakefield Tandoori - A 3-minute walk.

Chans Super Kitchen - Cantonese & Peking Cuisine, 3-minute walk.

KFC - Bottom of Kirkley High Street - has a drive through facility (5 minutes by car).

TACO Bell - Bottom of Lowestoft high street (10 minutes by car).

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NATHAN & SALLY – RECOMMEND



Nathan & Sally have over 50 years hospitality knowledge.

Nathan trained as a chef and got his diploma in hotel management at Lowestoft College. Sally was a graduate trainee at Harrods before heading up the retail catering operation at Selfridges. Sally and Nathan met when working at Nathan's foodservice company in London. Below are their personal recommendations for eating in the area, which they do a lot.

NATHAN EXPLAINS:

"We made the decision to close our restaurant and bar due to ongoing challenges such as staffing shortages, rising energy costs, and a limited demand for fine dining in the local community.

Instead, we've transformed the hotel into a self-catering operation and are passionate about supporting local, independently run hospitality businesses. That's why we created this guide - to help you discover some of our favourite places to eat nearby."

Breakfast

We usually skip this, but are partial to an egg & sausage **McMuffin** from the golden arches brand. Recently a local café called **Pakefield Pantry** has opened serving cooked breakfasts just a stones through from the hotel (turn right) and it has been getting rave reviews.

But for us our spotlight would be **SUNRISE@Zaks** down on the beach front for a bacon buttie and a flat white coffee.

Quick & Easy

Mr Chips was discovered by Nathan when refurbishing the hotel. Having grown up in a local chip shop, Nathan is really impressed with the quality of fish and chips. He suggests sharing a portion of chips (which are quite exceptional) as the portions are huge and the haddock excellent. Why not try this with a bottle of chilled Chablis from the **Co-op** next door and sit in our secluded garden?

Mr Chips also does superb chicken and lamb kebabs; Nathan suggests asking for the chilli sauce and garlic sauce served separately. **Mention Nathan and that you are staying at The First Light Hotel, and you might get a treat!** Cold beers from the **Co-op** next door.

PUB Life

Our favourite, locally is **The Ship** in Stradbroke Road. Take the path opposite the hotel entrance and then turn left on to Stradbroke Road. The guest ales rotate regularly here but the backdrop offer of lagers, beers and ales are all recognisable top brands. Food here is very good, you will probably need to book for a Sunday lunch. All the sports channels are available, and the big fixtures are shown. **Ask for Donna & Carl and say that Nathan and Sally recommended it you and you are staying at the First Light Hotel.**

Alternatively, we often get the bus to Southwold for lunch or dinner and go to our friend's pub, **The Red Lion** in Southwold. This serves all the Adnams beer, wine and spirits brands and does decent pub grub. Best to call in advance and book as it gets busy.

If you want a beautiful open water place for sundown, try **The Commodore** in Oulton Broad and if you want to view the sea from the cliff tops we suggest **The Jolly Sailors**, which often has live music on a Saturday / Sunday. Both are operations of the local Moss & Co brand serving food also.

Restaurants

For us, the best restaurant in town is **Mark G's**. You will need a taxi for this as it is at the top end of the town centre high street. Mark went to college with Nathan and is an exceptional chef, specialising in fish cookery. Mark and his partner Jo have also curated a wine bar next door called **GG's Bistro** for smaller tapas style plates. Book in advance to be sure to get a seat and **ask for Mark or Jo and do let them know that you are staying at First Light Hotel.**

If fine dining is your thing, then visit our former chef Terry at **The Swan** in Southwold. There are two restaurants here, one serving fine dining and the other serving decent pub bistro food. Further up the high street is the sister hotel **The Crown**, serving brasserie style dishes for lunch and dinner.

If you are not driving, a taxi is expensive at around £25 each way. So why not grab a pint at **The Tramway** and get a bus to Southwold, check times of services.

If you fancy a burger and cocktails, then we recommend **JoJo's** at 93 High St, Lowestoft.

If you are looking for something spicy then try **Lowestoft Tandoori**. Both these establishments also do take aways if you wanted to chill in the back garden and stay closer to home.
