However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Service of Funeral Director and Staff**\$2,250.00**

Our services include conducting the arrangements conference; planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; shelter of remains; preparing and filing of necessary notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming**\$950.00**

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Other Preparation of the Body**\$230.00**

This service includes normal cosmetology, hair dressing, shaving, dressing, and casketing of the body or washing, disinfecting, and casketing of the remains if no embalming.

Receiving Remains from another Funeral Home**\$2,895.00**

This charge includes basic service and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory. Additional charges will apply for added services and merchandise.

Immediate Burial**\$3,040.00 to \$23,040.00**

This charge includes basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains; and local transportation to cemetery. This charge does not allow any ceremonies or attendance of services. Additional charges will apply for added services or merchandise.

Direct Cremation**\$2,490.00 to \$22,490.00**

Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are a cardboard box or lightweight plastic pouch.

Night and Weekend Funeral Services

Any Service after 4:00 pm will incur an additional \$250.00 fee. Any Service on Saturday will incur an additional \$500.00 fee. No services will be held on Sunday.

Media Obituaries

If any media, including local media, makes a charge for publishing obituaries, that charge will be forwarded to the family.

Death Certificates

As of the effective date of this price list the charge for certified Death Certificates is \$20.00 for the first copy and \$3.00 for each additional copy ordered at the same time. The charge for Death Certificates is exactly what the State of Texas charges. Any Death Certificates ordered from Parker County, or any other County will be at the current price of that County.

Security Traffic Escort

When a funeral procession crosses any major streets or intersections a safety escort will be required. Any fees associated will be forwarded to the family.

Hair Dressing or Other Special Cosmetics Treatments

Hairdressers or Cosmetologist are available upon request. A minimum fee of \$50 or their current market price will be forwarded to the family.

Special Letters or Authorizations

Medical Examiner's Cremation Authorization Letters \$35.00 or more, TDC Furlough Request Letters \$10.00 per letter, all other special request letters \$3.00 per letter plus cost.

Cemetery Fees and Cost of Interment

Most rural cemeteries charge an interment fee or a maintenance fee payable on each grave space used. Some rural cemeteries also charge for each grave space. Almost all the rural cemeteries are either privately owned or are maintained by a cemetery association, consequently they need the interment fees to assist with cemetery maintenance.

Musicians or Ministers

If a minister, musician, or vocalist needs to be contacted we will be more than happy to assist. Normal fees for musicians or vocalists are \$200 each and ministers are \$250 each. If no charge is made by the minister, musician, or vocalist there will be no charge to the family. If a charge is more than the abovementioned price, that charge will be forwarded on to the family.

Cremation Specific Information

Many families today are choosing cremation. Galbreath Pickard operates their own cremation facility and is the only crematory in Parker County. We ensure comfort and peace-of-mind that your loved one's cremation will be handled with the highest standards of care.

All funeral homes advertise "cremation services" however, some area funeral homes subcontract out this important service to distant crematories far down the highway. This is not the case with Galbreath Pickard Funeral Homes and Cremation Services. Your loved one never leaves our care and only our Certified Cremation Specialists will care for them.

Since we are an actual crematory operator and are privileged to serve numerous cremation families every year, you have the peace-of-mind in knowing that you have retained a "Cremation Expert." Let us share some of that knowledge with you so you can be an informed consumer.

Financing Options

We strive to assist families in all walks of life, however sometimes our day-to-day routines put us in a bind both financially and emotionally. **We require financial arrangements to be made prior to finalizing any funeral services.** We offer the following options to pay for services and merchandise we provide to your family.

- We accept cash, check, credit, or debit cards.
- We will assist in filing verifiable assignable insurance policies. A fee of \$250 will be charged for this service.
- We will work with financial institutions if you have acquired your own financing.
- We have access to a "Crowd Funding Portal" we can link directly to the obituary page on our website.
- Payment by Estate: Because it may take up to a year to probate and settle an estate, the Funeral Home does not accept this form of payment except in situations that are approved in writing by the manager of the Funeral Home. We will charge an estate filing fee of \$500.00 to the funeral bill. If due to a delay in processing an insurance claim, probating an estate, or some other cause, the full payment is not received within 30 days of the date of the funeral, a late penalty of 2.5% per month will be applied to the outstanding balance of the funeral bill.

If families have limited or no financial means to pay for funeral services or merchandise, we may require families to select specific types of services and merchandise. Due to Federal Regulations in effect as of January 1, 2011, we will no longer be able to assist families with long term financing.
