Rules & Format:

- 1. This event will be certified by GSA-USBC.**
- 2. All scholarship funds will be administered by S.M.A.R.T.**
- 3. In this tournament, a youth bowler is open to ALL bowlers age 21 and younger as of August 1, 2025. If the youth bowler is a P.B.A. member, the youth bowler will not be able to participate in this tournament.**
- 4. Bowlers will enter with the highest of either their 2024-2025 or their 2025-2026 verifiable average of 18+ games or more.**
 - o If the bowler only carries a sport/challenge average, we will adjust the average to a house average.**
 - o If no averages in either 2024-2025 or 2025-2026, we will use a current average with at least twelve games for the 2025-2026 season for youth bowlers.**
 - NOTE: If any bowler had 18+ games in just the 2024-2025 or 2025-2026 seasons, we may use that average**
 - If bowler has no averages whatsoever. Handicap will be 85% of 230.**
- 5. All bowlers may be rerated or adjusted at the discretion of the tournament directors. If you have been rerated in the last 12 months, please provide the average that you had to use.**
- 6. This tournament will have three divisions depending on how many are participating:**
 - o Division 1 – 170 and above**
 - o Division 2 – 169 and below**
 - o Division 3 – Any average – Girls only**
 - Girls can elect to bowl against the boys in their respective average division.**
- 7. Bowlers who enter with the incorrect average may be subject to forfeiture of scholarships earned at such tournaments.**
- 8. All bowlers will bowl 4 games of qualifying, moving two pairs of lanes after each game. Top bowlers in each division will enter a stair step finals bracket within their respective division.**
- 9. Scholarships will be guaranteed to the top four youth bowlers in each division, assuming we have 20 bowlers in each Division. If a division has more or less than 20 participants, scholarships awarded may change based upon actual numbers.**

- 11. Pre-pay your spot via registration link on first page or register online and pay cash on day of tournament. No walk-ins allowed. Tournament fee is \$40.00 per person. If GSA-USBC membership has not yet been paid for the 2025-2026 season, please add \$13.00 for GSA-USBC membership.**
- 12. We encourage proper attire. No sweatpants, basketball shorts, or T-shirts.**
- 13. USBC Rules will govern any aspect of tournament played that is not addressed above.**
