Dress Code: All bowlers must wear suitable attire. All clothing must be neat, clean and in good condition. **No** inappropriate advertisement will be allowed on any attire or equipment. Jeans, slacks, walking shorts, Capri pants, skirts and hats are permitted. **No** t-shirts, tank tops, sweats, gym shorts, or cut-offs of any kind allowed. The tournament staff shall determine the validity of any dress code complaints and enforce as necessary.

Tournament Rules

Eligibility: All participants must be Greater Sacramento Area USBC members.

Average: Entrants will use their highest 2024-25 winter or 2025 summer season average of at least 21 games. If none, entrants must provide the league standing sheet from the current season of at least 21 games. If neither of the above averages is available, then the entrant will be assigned an average of 220.

Entrants are responsible for verifying their own average at the time the entry form is submitted. If the tournament committee finds that the reported average is incorrect, then a corrected average will be used and the entrant may be disqualified.

Format: Bowlers will bowl 3 games of singles on one pair of lanes, and will compete on a scratch basis within each of the categories delineated on the front of the entry form. **Highest <u>handicap</u> scores** within each category of man, woman, youth girl and youth boy will be eligible to advance to the California State BVL championships.

In case of a tie, the highest individual game of the 3 game set will advance to the state championship.

Awards: A ratio of at least 1:6 will be used for all awards. USBC SMART account #9470 will Receive all scholarship awards for youth winners.

Other Rules:

- **Conduct:** Good sportsmanship is required by all participants. Any un-sportsmen like behavior will be addressed by the tournament committee and may result in a warning or disqualification.
- **General Provisions:** Only participants and tournament personnel are allowed in the settee area. No food or drink is allowed in the settee area and no alcoholic beverage or smoking/vaping is permitted. No powdery product (e.g.. Easy Slide, baby powder) may be applied to bowling shoes at any time. No audio devices are permitted in the settee area. Compliance with the dress code will be monitored by the tournament Committee.
- **Protests/Appeals:** Any protest or appeal must be received by the Greater Sacramento Area USBC office within 72 hours of the infraction.
- **USBC Rules:** USBC rules will govern any aspect of tournament play that is not specifically addressed in these rules.
