Your flu and COVID-19 vaccines

If you are 75 years old or over, live or work in a care home, or have a weaker immune system, you are entitled to a free COVID-19 vaccine. You are also entitled to a free winter flu vaccine if you're over 50, pregnant, or a health or care worker.

How to get them

If you've received an invitation, follow the instructions to book your appointment - you can also call our helpline on the number above or visit the online booking portal to book the appointment. Or you can visit one of our drop-in clinics - you don't need an appointment, though you may have to wait.
