### **BAPTISM:**

Baptisms are held in Spanish on the First and Fourth Sunday of each month and Baptisms are held in English on the second and third Sunday of each month after Mass (1:30 PM). Parents must attend a Baptismal Preparation class. Our English Baptismal Prep Class is held on the last Friday of each month at 6:00 PM and our Spanish Baptismal Prep Class is held on the last Thursday of the month at 7:00 PM.

### **MARRIAGE:**

In accordance with the Common Policy for Catholic Churches in New Jersey, couples are asked to arrange the wedding date one year in advance. Pre-marital instructions are required. Please contact the Rectory for an appointment.

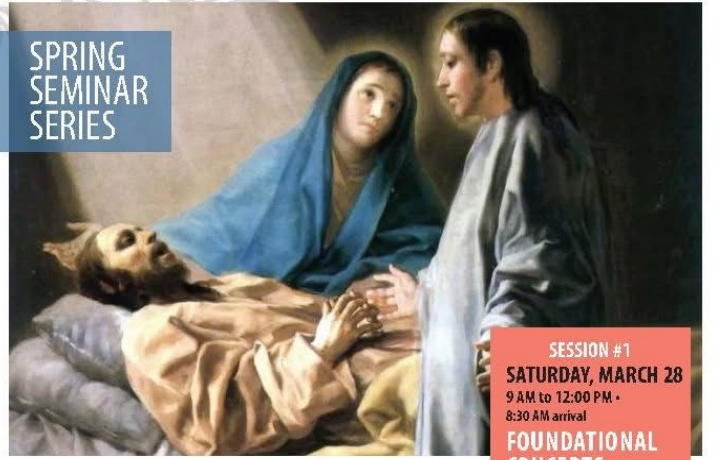

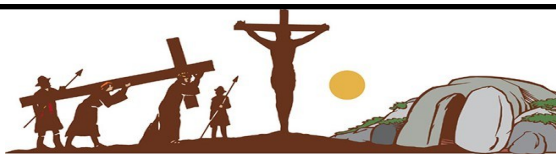

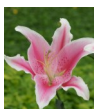

Day 26 of Lent – **Becoming More like Christ**

2 Corinthians 3:18 – **“WE ARE BEING TRANSFORMED INTO HIS IMAGE”**

**MEDITATION:**

The goal of the Christian life is not simply avoiding sin, it is becoming like Jesus. Transformation happens gradually, through grace and cooperation. Every time you pray, forgive, show kindness, or choose humility, your heart becomes more like His.

Lent is a season of imitation. Look at Jesus in His gentleness, His strength, His compassion, His courage, and ask yourself: “Lord, make my heart like Yours.” You are being transformed even now, often in ways you cannot see.

**Reflection Questions:**

1. What Christ-like quality is God forming in me?
2. What is one area where I need to imitate Him more closely?
