SACRAMENT OF PENANCE: Saturdays 4:30-5:00 PM (English & Spanish). Or by appointment.

BAPTISM:

Arrangements must be made in advance at the Rectory. Baptisms are held in Spanish on the First and Fourth Sunday of each month and Baptisms are held in English on the second and third Sunday of each month after Mass (1:30 PM). Parents must attend a Baptismal Preparation class. Our English Baptismal Prep Class is held on the last Friday of each month at 6:00 PM and our Spanish Baptismal Prep Class is held on the last Thursday of the month at 7:00 PM.

MARRIAGE:

In accordance with the Common Policy for Catholic Churches in New Jersey, couples are asked to arrange the wedding date one year in advance. Pre-marital instructions are required. Please contact the Rectory for an appointment.

CARE OF THE SICK:

If someone you know is sick or in the hospital, please notify the Rectory. Arrangements will be made to bring the Sacraments to them.

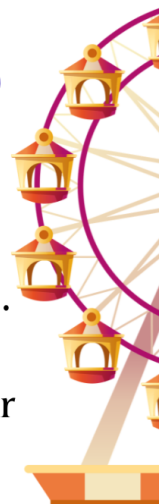

Today's Word reminds us of who we truly are: a chosen race, a royal priesthood, called not by our own merit, but by God's grace. In Acts, the early Church faced tension yet responded with trust and discernment, allowing the Spirit of Jesus to guide them. That same Spirit is alive in our parish today. We are not alone.
