Our Lady of Guadalupe



Nearly 500 years ago, the Virgin Mary appeared in Mexico. Hers was a message of love, mercy and reconciliation. Within 30 years of her apparition, nearly 5 million indigenous people were converted to Catholicism! To this day, the miraculous tilma upon which her image was impressed is enshrined in the Basilica in Mexico City. Mary's deepest desire is to lead us to Jesus. Her main request when she appeared at Tepeyac was to have a temple —Catholic Church— built where her son would be worshiped: where the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass would be celebrated for centuries to come. Our Lady of Guadalupe is the Patroness of the National Eucharistic Revival.

The Novena of our Lady of Guadalupe will take place in the church with the reciting of the Rosary each day December 3rd thru December 11th.

A full schedule of the Novena, Vigil, and Feast Day will be available soon.
