SACRAMENT OF PENANCE: Saturdays 4:30-5:00 PM (English & Spanish). Or by appointment.

BAPTISM:

Arrangements must be made in advance at the Rectory. Baptisms are held in Spanish on the First and Fourth Sunday of each month and Baptisms are held in English on the second and third Sunday of each month after Mass (1:00 PM). Parents must attend a Baptismal Preparation class. Our English Baptismal Prep Class is held on the last Friday of each month at 7:30 PM in the Guadalupe Room and our Spanish Baptismal Prep Class is held on the last Thursday of the month at 7:00 PM.

MARRIAGE:

In accordance with the Common Policy for Catholic Churches in New Jersey, couples are asked to arrange the wedding date one year in advance. Pre-marital instructions are required. Please contact the Rectory for an appointment.

Our Lady of Guadalupe

Nearly 500 years ago, the Virgin Mary appeared in Mexico. Hers was a message of love, mercy and reconciliation. Within 30 years of her apparition, nearly 5 million indigenous people were converted to Catholicism! To this day, the miraculous tilma upon which her image was impressed is enshrined in the Basilica in Mexico City. Mary's deepest desire is to lead us to Jesus. Her main request when she appeared at Tepeyac was to have a temple —Catholic Church— built where her son would be worshiped: where the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass would be celebrated for centuries to come. Our Lady of Guadalupe is the Patroness of the National Eucharistic Revival.
