





Opening Doors for the Unreached

Today, there are more than 8.2 billion people in the world—and nearly 42% of them have never truly heard about Jesus. That means almost half the world still lives without a church nearby, a missionary to share the gospel, or a believer in their community.


Assemblies of God World Missions has launched a bold new vision called Gospel Access, a movement to reach those who have never had the chance to hear.

Their goal is to grow the global missionary family from 2,569 to 4,000 by 2033, sending more workers to the hardest-to-reach places on earth.

As part of Kingdom Builders, our Multiply Church Family is standing with this vision. We're giving, praying, and believing that everyone deserves access to the life-changing message of Jesus.

Our 2026 theme, Elevate, calls us to lift our faith to new levels—to believe for what has never been seen. Together, we can help move the gospel into places where it has never gone before.

From Humble Roots, to Global Impact

When Hal Donaldson was just twelve years old, a tragedy forever changed the course of his life. In 1969, his parents were struck by a drunk driver. His father, a pastor, died in the crash, and his mother was seriously injured. The surviving family—Hal, his siblings, and his mother—found themselves relying on the compassion of neighbors, churches, and strangers who stepped in to help provide food and support.

Years later, Hal—already wrestling with questions of purpose and meaning—traveled to India. There, in an encounter with Mother Teresa, he felt the weight of a single question: What are you doing to help the poor and the suffering? That question lingered, and he sensed a calling far beyond mere intentions. In 1994, alongside his brothers Steve and Dave, Hal launched what would become Convoy of Hope. Their humble beginnings


included “Care Days,” outreach events where food and supplies were given to communities in need. Over time, the work grew more organized and ambitious. In 1995, Convoy distributed 700,000 pounds of food to 70,000 people.

By 1996, Convoy moved its headquarters to Springfield, Missouri, after Hal accepted a position there and relocated the organization. A local donor contributed a semi-truck along with fuel and a driver for a year, enabling Convoy’s relief efforts to gain momentum.

As the years progressed, Convoy of Hope evolved from distributing food at community events into a multifaceted humanitarian organization. In 2000, they purchased

a 300,000-square-foot warehouse in Springfield to store supplies. When Hurricane Katrina struck in 2005, Convoy delivered \$35 million in goods — roughly 700 truckloads — as part of its relief role.

In 2006, Convoy extended its reach further: in the U.S. and internationally, it provided food, medical care, clothing, and other services to nearly 4 million people in that year alone. The following year, Convoy began partnering with USAID to offer daily meals to 12,000 children in countries such as Kenya, Haiti, Nicaragua, and El Salvador. By 2014, after two decades of growth, Convoy had served an estimated 67 million people across more than 100 countries.



Generosity That Echoes Across Nations

Today, Convoy of Hope stands as one of the most respected humanitarian organizations in the world. As of 2025, they have distributed over \$3.1 billion in food, water, and supplies, serving more than 300 million people globally. In the U.S., their Community Events often deliver more than \$1 million in goods and services in a single day—free health care, dental screenings, groceries, job training, haircuts, family portraits, and more—partnering with churches, businesses, and volunteers.

Their Women’s Empowerment programs have touched tens of thousands of women and girls, offering vocational training, business skills, seed capital, and mentoring. In recent years, they empowered more than 61,000 women and girls worldwide. At the same time, their Children’s

Feeding initiative in developing regions has grown so that now 639,000 children receive meals on school days across multiple countries.

When disasters strike—floods, hurricanes, earthquakes—Convoy is among the first responders. They maintain warehouses, mobile units, trained staff, and logistics to deliver relief worldwide. Through it all, the heartbeat remains unchanged: a family’s experience of receiving help turned into a movement of giving, carrying forward the same compassion shown to young Hal Donaldson. From a single pickup truck and a handful of volunteers to a global force of hope impacting millions, Convoy of Hope’s story reminds us that great things often begin with small acts of faith—and that generosity can echo across nations.


The Multiply Family of Churches is committed to restoring the full expression of the church as Jesus designed it—apostolic in mission, prophetic in voice, evangelistic in reach, shepherding in care, and teaching in depth (Ephesians 4:11–13). From God’s first command to “be fruitful and multiply” (Genesis 1:28) to the multiplying church in Acts, Scripture reveals multiplication as a core mandate for God’s people.

In 2026, this multiplying vision will take tangible form through new church plants, including **Multiply Raleigh** and **Multiply Rowan**, each serving as local expressions of a shared spiritual DNA. These plants reflect Multiply’s commitment to raising disciples, developing leaders, and establishing healthy, Spirit-empowered churches rooted in their communities.

Through your Kingdom Builder partnership, Multiply is taking a bold step into Europe through the planting of Multiply Church in Rennes, France. **Multiply Rennes** will embody a Spirit-empowered, apostolic expression of the church—forming disciples through community, faithful biblical teaching, and active participation in God’s mission—planting the gospel within a highly secular cultural context while calling people back to the life, freedom, and purpose found in Christ.

In France, secularism (laïcité) has shaped society such that large portions of the population identify as non-religious, and regular church attendance is among the lowest in the world, even where people culturally identify as Christian. This environment reflects a need for fresh expressions of faith and spiritual awakening—particularly

in cities like Rennes where historic Christian heritage exists alongside modern indifference to organized religion. The Multiply Family of Churches believes multiplication is not merely a strategy but a divine inheritance. As disciples are formed and churches are planted, renewed expressions of ecclesia emerge — advancing the Kingdom of God across cities, nations, and generations.

Way of The Cross - Prison Ministry

A Prisoner's Story of Redemption

I never thought a day like this would come. Yet here I am, in the prison parking lot, a metal trough of cold water in front of me and a heart that finally feels alive. I joined the Way of the Cross Bible study just to break the routine, but week after week the Scriptures cut through my defenses. I learned about a Jesus who doesn't just forgive sins—He forgives sinners. He brings freedom even to people still in chains. That truth changed me.

The night I surrendered to Christ, I felt clean for the first time in years—like the weight I'd carried was finally gone. And today, I'm going public with that decision.

The volunteers form a circle as the sun sets over the razor wire. For once, this place doesn't feel like a cage—it feels like holy ground. My hands shake as I step forward. The leader reads Romans 6, and I know exactly what I'm leaving behind.

I climb into the water. "Do you confess Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior?"
"Yes."

Cornerfield Market

Finding Community in Times of Need

I never expected to find God here. I came to Cornerfield Market for food and support—not faith. Church felt distant. But it wasn't the four walls that met me first. It was God's love, shown through people. Volunteers looked me in the eyes and prayed with me. Their conversations were genuine. Their embraces carried no judgment. Through them, God was reminding me that I was still loved and still had value in His eyes. Every time I walked into the Dream Center, I felt seen. That community became a home. And through that love, I was led back to Jesus, baptized, and given a restored life in Christ. Still walking through life's challenges—but no longer walking alone.

Chloe's Story, From Brokenness to Hope


I grew up in South Korea in a home that was very hard. My parents separated when I was little, and my mom struggled with addiction. Many times, I was left alone and had to take care of myself. There was verbal and physical abuse, and it left me feeling hurt, scared, and wishing I was loved.

When I found Present Age Ministries, everything began to change. I found a safe place and learned about God's love for me. Through caring mentors, counseling, and people who truly showed up for me, I started to understand my value and believe that my life could be different.

BGMC

Boys and Girls Missionary Challenge (BGMC) engages, teaches, and discipless our youngest generation in God's mission to reach the lost! This is accomplished by creating a heart of compassion in kids for the world's and our missionaries' needs. Kids are challenged to pray for our missionaries, sacrificially give to missions, and reach the lost in their own area. Funds raised through BGMC go to meet critical needs around the world with a special emphasis on Kids Helping Kids. Additional project focuses include curriculum translation and development, kids' outreaches, humanitarian aid, medical care, child welfare missions (foster care and orphanages), water initiatives, feeding programs, and anything else a missionary may need to spread the love of Jesus.



SPEED THE LIGHT



Speed the Light (STL) is a missions program that empowers students and churches to actively support missionaries around the world by providing the practical tools they need to share the Gospel. Founded in 1944 as a student-led initiative, Speed the Light focuses on raising funds for essential equipment such as vehicles, boats, media technology, and ministry resources—helping missionaries go farther, communicate clearly, and reach people faster with the message of Jesus. More than fundraising, Speed the Light is a discipleship movement. It teaches young people the value of sacrifice, generosity, and obedience as they partner in the Great Commission. Through giving, prayer, and missions engagement, students learn that their faith can make a real, global impact—advancing God’s Kingdom and bringing hope to communities around the world.

“He Had Already Provided”

As Pastor Rob Kettering said on Kingdom Building Sunday, “When God places a desire to give in our heart, it’s because He already has in His hand what we need to give.” I experienced that truth firsthand during the Kingdom Builders Banquet on November 9th, 2025.

When I picked up a Miracle Offering envelope, I prayed, “Lord, show me what You want me to give.” As I wrote, I felt God leading me to give \$1,000. Almost immediately, doubt crept in—I didn’t see how that amount was possible by the offering date. Still, I trusted God and held onto the envelope.

That Friday, after seeing only \$192 in my bank account, I decided to give \$100 online, thinking at least I was giving something. Right after I closed my

banking app, my phone notified me that I had received a \$100 Zelle. I was amazed and encouraged, reminded again that God is my Provider.

The next day, I found an unexpected insurance reimbursement check in the mail for \$2,192. Though my first thoughts were about bills, the amount God had placed on my heart kept returning. On Sunday, I gave another \$200, and later that week, I finally gave the remaining \$700.

The moment I did, a heavy burden lifted from me, replaced with joy and freedom. God reminded me that He had already provided what He asked me to give—He was simply inviting me to trust and obey. I am so thankful for the joy of giving and for the reminder that God truly is our Provider.

"Beyond Anything I Imagined"

The week of the Miracle Offering, I sensed the Lord place a specific amount on my heart—an amount we simply didn't have. On the way to church that morning, I told my wife, "We don't have the money." She looked at me and asked, "So what are we going to do?" All I could say was, "I'm going to trust God to work it out."

Honestly, in my own mind, I was already trying to figure out how to rob Peter to pay Paul. My faith felt small, and doubt was loud. But I gave anyway—believing that obedience mattered more than my math.

What happened next was nothing I could have arranged on my own. Doors began to open. Opportunities I didn't pursue found me. Favor came from places I didn't know were paying attention. Unexpected provision began showing up again and again.

Before long, God had blessed me far beyond anything I imagined. And from that blessing, I was able to give even more to the Miracle Offering... four times the amount God originally laid on my heart.

How Do I Participate?

PLAN

First, make a plan to give. When you have plans and are diligent, it leads to plenty (Proverbs 21:5). God is excited when you have a plan! Whatever the amount is—have the plan in place, work the plan and be obedient to it. Start with what God has already blessed you with.

VISION

Next, ask God to give you a vision for what He could do through you with His help. This is beyond what you can do with your natural income. This requires you to take a step of faith. Additionally, Habakkuk 2:2 tells us to write that vision down and pray about it, so do that! God will supply all your needs according to His riches in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:19). Stepping out in faith pleases God. When you look at what He has in His hands, it goes to another level!

DREAM

Lastly, what would be a dream amount you could give? Hold on to this dream. This number is only between you and God. Watch as each step of faith you take, God moves you closer to that dream. God can do exceedingly abundantly more than all we can ask for or imagine (Ephesians 3:20). Then celebrate when God fulfills it!

Now more than ever, make a plan to give, ask God for a vision in your generosity and hold on to the dream of what God will do as you step out in faith!


