A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR:

What if God isn't looking at your resume?

What if God isn't impressed with your skill-set

What if it's not about what you can do, but about what you can believe?

Because God doesn't build things according to the level of our ability.

He builds according to the level of our faith. This year is about increasing our FAITH capacity. We've spent years sharpening our abilities, collecting knowledge, and perfecting our leadership strategies. And that's good. That honors God. But that only brings incremental growth—in the situation you're already in.

If you want to step onto a whole new playing field, if you're going to build what eyes have not seen nor ears have heard, you've got to elevate. Kingdom expansion operates in a different realm. Not the realm of ability but the realm of faith. Hebrews 11 says, "Faith is the manifestation of things hoped for. Faith is the evidence of things not seen."

There's a visible realm. And there's an invisible realm. A seen world and an unseen world. And the unseen world? That's the higher reality. That's the realm where faith is the currency, where your trust is the transaction, where heaven's resources move when earth believes.

But here's the problem: Too many of us live stuck under the circumstances. Bound by the five senses. We live below. Beneath. Never elevating into the faith realm. Others do step up into that realm, but they stay there—dreaming, hoping, envisioning, and never bringing heaven down to earth, never manifesting the unseen into the seen. But it's not about your seating capacity. It's not about your giving capacity. It's not about your leadership capacity. It's about your FAITH capacity. From Abel to Abraham. From Moses to Rahab. From David to Samuel. We're walking through the Hall of Faith, not just to read their stories of history, but convinced that the chapters of faith are still being written by heaven's pen, yearning for our lives to tell stories like theirs.

This is the year we climb higher.

This is the year we spiral upward.

This is the year we:

Elevate our thinking. Elevate our words, Elevate and our faith.

So lift your eyes.

Lift your heart.

Lift your faith.

It's time to ELEVATE.

DAY 1

EMMANUEL GOD WITH US

MEANING:

God is present, near, and with His people in every moment.

KEY VERSE: Matthew 1:23

“Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel, which means ‘God is with us.’

DECLARE:

I declare that God is with me. Wherever I go, He goes.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

To assure God’s people that He had not abandoned them.

What did the name mean to them?

God was closer than their fear.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus is God-with-us then, now, and forever.

PRAYER:

Lord, thank You for being with me today. Help me feel Your nearness and rest in Your presence. When I feel alone, draw me close again. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 2 JEHOVAH JIREH THE LORD WILL PROVIDE

MEANING:

God sees ahead and provides what we need at the right time.

KEY VERSE: Genesis 22:14

“The Lord will provide.”

DECLARE:

I declare that God is my provider, and He will supply every need.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God provided a substitute sacrifice for Abraham.

What did the name mean to them?

God is trustworthy and always on time.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus is God’s ultimate provision for us.

PRAYER:

Father, thank You for seeing my needs and providing for me. Help me trust Your timing. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 3

EL SHADDAI

GOD ALMIGHTY

MEANING:

God is all-powerful and more than enough.

KEY VERSE: Genesis 17:1
“I am El-Shaddai—God Almighty.”

DECLARE:

I declare that nothing is impossible for my God.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God promised Abraham a miracle beyond natural ability.

What did the name mean to them?
Security in unstable times.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?
Jesus shows God’s strength through His love and humility.

PRAYER:

God Almighty, You are enough for every need. Strengthen my faith today. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 4

JEHOVAH MELECH OLAM

THE ETERNAL KING

MEANING:

God reigns forever and His kingdom never ends.

KEY VERSE: Psalm 10:16
“The Lord is King forever and ever.”

DECLARE:

I declare that God’s kingdom is unshakable—and so am I in Him.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

To remind people that God still rules, even when life feels chaotic.

What did the name mean to them?
God is trustworthy and always on time.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?
Jesus’ resurrection proves His everlasting kingship.

PRAYER:

Eternal King, rule in my heart today. Let Your peace steady me. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 5 JEHOVAH NISSI

THE LORD MY BANNER

MEANING:

God is our victory, covering, and identity.

KEY VERSE: Exodus 17:15
"The Lord is my banner."

DECLARE:

I declare that I stand under the banner of God's victory.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God gave Israel victory in battle.

What did the name mean to them?

The power came from God, not themselves.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus is lifted up as our victory over sin and death.

PRAYER:

Lord, thank You for fighting for me. Lift my eyes to You today. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 6

JEHOVAH SHALOM

THE LORD IS PEACE

MEANING:

God Himself is our peace in every storm.

KEY VERSE: Judges 6:24
"The Lord is peace."

DECLARE:

I declare that God's peace guards my heart and mind.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

Gideon encountered God's calming presence.

What did the name mean to them?

Peace was a Person, not a feeling.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus brings peace with God and peace within..

PRAYER:

Lord, be my peace today. Calm my worries and steady my heart. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 7

JEHOVAH TSIKENU

THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS

MEANING:

God makes us clean and accepted through Christ.

KEY VERSE: Jeremiah 23:6
“The Lord is our righteousness.”

DECLARE:

I declare that I am righteous through Christ alone.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God promised to make His people right again.

What did the name mean to them?

Salvation came from God, not their efforts.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus is our righteousness fully and forever.

PRAYER:

Jesus, thank You for making me clean and accepted. Help me walk in Your grace today. Amen.

DAY 8

JEHOVAH SHAMMAH

THE LORD IS THERE

MEANING:

God's presence dwells with His people.

KEY VERSE: Ezekiel 48:35
“The Lord is there.”

DECLARE:

I declare that God's peace guards my heart and mind.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God promised His presence would return to His people.

What did the name mean to them?

Hope that God would be near again.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Through the Holy Spirit, God is with us always.

PRAYER:

Lord, be my peace today. Calm my worries and steady my heart. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 9

ADONAI LORD AND MASTER

MEANING:

God is our loving Leader and the One we gladly follow.

KEY VERSE:

Psalm 8:1

"O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens"

DECLARE:

I declare that Jesus is Lord over my life.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

To honor God's authority and the relationship of trust.

What did the name mean to them?

God wasn't distant, He was personal.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Following Jesus means trusting His leadership.

PRAYER:

Adonai, lead me today. I choose to follow Your ways with joy. Amen.

DAY 10

EL ROI THE GOD WHO SEES ME

MEANING:

God sees every need, every tear, and every moment of my life.

KEY VERSE:

Genesis 16:13

"You are the God who sees me."

DECLARE:

I declare that I am seen, known, and loved by God.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

Hagar realized God saw her pain.

What did the name mean to them?

God notices the overlooked.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus meets us in our broken places.

PRAYER:

Lord, thank You for seeing me and caring for me. Help me feel Your compassion today. Amen.

DAY 11

ELOHIM CREATOR GOD

MEANING:

God is the powerful Creator who designed everything, including me.

KEY VERSE:

Genesis 1:1
“In the beginning, God created. . .”

DECLARE:

I declare that my life is God-designed and full of purpose.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

To show God’s creative power.

What did the name mean to them?

God is the source of all life.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus is the Word through whom all things were made.

PRAYER:

Creator God, thank You for designing my life with purpose. Help me trust Your plan. Amen.

DAY 12

EL ELYON GOD MOST HIGH

MEANING:

God is above every power, fear, and situation.

KEY VERSE:

Psalms 7:17
“The Lord Most High.”

DECLARE:

I declare that God is higher than anything I face.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

To declare God’s supremacy.

What did the name mean to them?

God is higher than every enemy.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus reigns with all authority.

PRAYER:

Most High God, lift my eyes above my problems to Your greatness. Amen.

DAY 13

EL OLAM EVERLASTING GOD

MEANING:

God is eternal and unchanging,
steady in every season.

KEY VERSE: Genesis 21:33
"The Eternal God"

DECLARE:

I declare that God is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

To remind believers that God never changes.

What did the name mean to them?

He is faithful through all seasons.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus is the Eternal Son who reigns forever.

PRAYER:

Everlasting God, thank You for being my constant. Help me rest in Your unchanging love. Amen.

DAY 14

EL KANA THE JEALOUS GOD

MEANING:

God desires our whole heart and
protects His relationship with us.

KEY VERSE: Exodus 34:14
"The Lord... is a jealous God."

DECLARE:

I declare that my heart belongs fully to God.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God wanted His people's full devotion.

What did the name mean to them?

Worship belongs to Him alone.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus restores us to wholehearted love for God.

PRAYER:

Lord, keep my heart focused on You. Remove anything that competes with You. Amen.

DAY 15 JEHOVAH ROHI

THE LORD IS MY SHEPHERD

MEANING:

God leads, guides, protects, and cares for us.

KEY VERSE: Psalm 23:1
"The Lord is my Shepherd."

DECLARE:

I declare that God guides my steps and watches over me.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God cares for His people like a shepherd.

What did the name mean to them?

He leads, protects, and provides.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus is the Good Shepherd who lays down His life.

PRAYER:

Shepherd of my soul, lead me today. Help me hear Your voice clearly. Amen.

DAY 16 JEHOVAH TSABA

THE LORD OF ARMIES

MEANING:

God commands heaven's armies and fights for His people.

KEY VERSE: Psalm 46:7
"The Lord of Heaven's Armies is here among us."

DECLARE:

I declare that the Lord fights for me, and I am never alone.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God defended His people in battles.

What did the name mean to them?

God was their warrior and protector.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus leads heaven's armies in victory.

PRAYER:

Lord of Armies, fight my battles today. Surround me with Your strength. Amen.

EL HANNE'EMAN

THE FAITHFUL GOD

MEANING:

God always keeps His promises.

KEY VERSE: Deuteronomy 7:9

DECLARE:

KEY VERSE: Psalms 27:1

DECLARE:

I declare that God's light guides me and gives me confidence.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

God gave courage when fear surrounded.

What did the name mean to them?

His presence brought clarity and peace.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus is the Light of the World.

PRAYER:

Lord, shine Your light on my path today. Remove fear and fill me with courage. Amen.

DAY 19

JEHOVAH RAPHA

THE LORD WHO HEALS

MEANING:

God heals minds, hearts,
bodies, and souls.

KEY VERSE: Exodus 15:26

DECLARE:

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Jesus sends the Helper, the Holy Spirit, to be with us.

PRAYER:

Lord, be my help today. Strengthen me and steady me when I feel weak. Amen.

DAY 21 JESUS CHRIST

THE NAME ABOVE EVERY NAME

MEANING:

Jesus is Savior, Lord, and the full revelation of God.

KEY VERSE: Philippians 2:9
“God gave Him the name above every name.”

DECLARE:

I declare that Jesus Christ is Lord over my life
—my hope, my strength, and my salvation.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

Why was this name used?

Jesus holds all authority in heaven and on earth.

What did the name mean to them?

Salvation and life were found only in His name.

What does the name mean in light of Jesus?

Every name of God is fulfilled in Christ.

PRAYER:

Jesus, I worship You as Savior and Lord. Let Your name be exalted in my life. Amen.
