2. Seek His Guidance Daily

Proverbs 3:5-6 reminds us to "trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight." Whether it's budgeting differently, selling something of value, or giving sacrificially, rely on His guidance as you walk in obedience to His call.

3. Celebrate God's Provision

As you stretch your faith, keep your eyes open for the ways God provides. It may be through unexpected blessings, increased opportunities, or divine favor. Celebrate each step of progress, no matter how small, and give God the glory for the work He's doing in and through you.

Present Age Ministries

Rescuing Hearts, Restoring Hope: The Story of Present Age Ministries

The young girl sat silently in the back of the room, her eyes darting to the floor whenever someone tried to meet her gaze. Her journey to this moment had been one of pain, manipulation, and trauma—an all-too-common story for the survivors of human trafficking. But here, in the embrace of Present Age Ministries (PAM), she was taking her first steps toward healing. For her and so many others like her, PAM represents a lifeline, a beacon of hope in a world that had once seemed hopeless.

Founded in North Carolina, Present Age Ministries was born out of a passionate desire to combat the sexual exploitation of teen girls. The statistics are harrowing: North Carolina consistently ranks among the top 10 states for human trafficking. Yet, within this crisis, PAM sees not only victims but also survivors—young women with untapped potential, waiting for someone to believe in them.

The organization's mission is both ambitious and compassionate: to rebuild trust, restore hope, and redefine love for those who have been exploited. While rooted in faith, PAM serves individuals from all backgrounds, offering a holistic approach to healing that addresses the mind, body, and spirit.

Planting Seeds of Prevention

Prevention is at the heart of PAM's work. The team knows that education is the most powerful tool to stop exploitation before it starts. Through programs like A Child's Choice™, they teach elementary school children how to establish boundaries and recognize unsafe situations. Middle schoolers learn about the deceptive tactics traffickers use through The Illusion of Love™, while at-risk teens are guided through an empowering eight-week curriculum called Discovering Your Value™.

Each program is crafted to meet young people where they are, equipping them with knowledge and skills to protect themselves and their peers.

Walking with Survivors

For those who have already endured the horrors of trafficking, PAM offers a haven of safety and support through their For the One survivor care program. It's here that the real healing begins. Case managers work closely with each survivor to create a personalized plan, while trauma-informed counselors help them process their experiences. Whether living with biological families, foster homes, or in group care, these girls are surrounded by a network of people who are fiercely committed to their recovery.

The impact of these efforts is evident in the lives transformed. A young woman once trapped in fear and silence now finds her voice through art therapy. Another, who struggled with trust, begins to believe in the possibility of a future filled with joy and purpose.

A Community United

PAM knows they cannot fight this battle alone. They engage entire communities, hosting workshops and seminars to educate adults about the realities of trafficking and how to recognize the warning signs. Their outreach has already touched thousands of lives, empowering people to become advocates for change.

Hope Beyond Borders

While their primary focus is on North Carolina, PAM's vision extends globally. Their initiatives in Nairobi, Kenya, demonstrate their belief that every girl, no matter where she lives, deserves a life free from exploitation.

A Shared Mission

The young girl who once stared at the floor now walks taller. Her journey is far from over, but with the unwavering support of Present Age Ministries, she knows she's not alone.

PAM's work is a reminder that change begins with one heart, one life, and one step at a time. Their story is one of resilience and redemption, a testament to what's possible when a community comes together to fight for justice.
