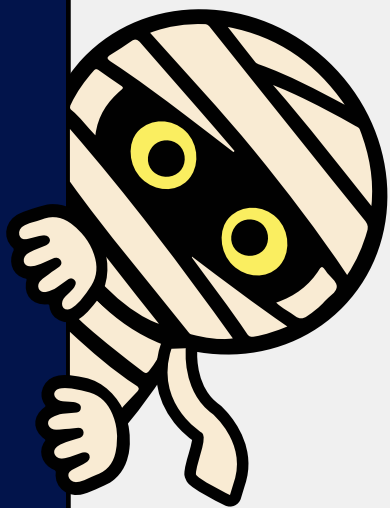


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

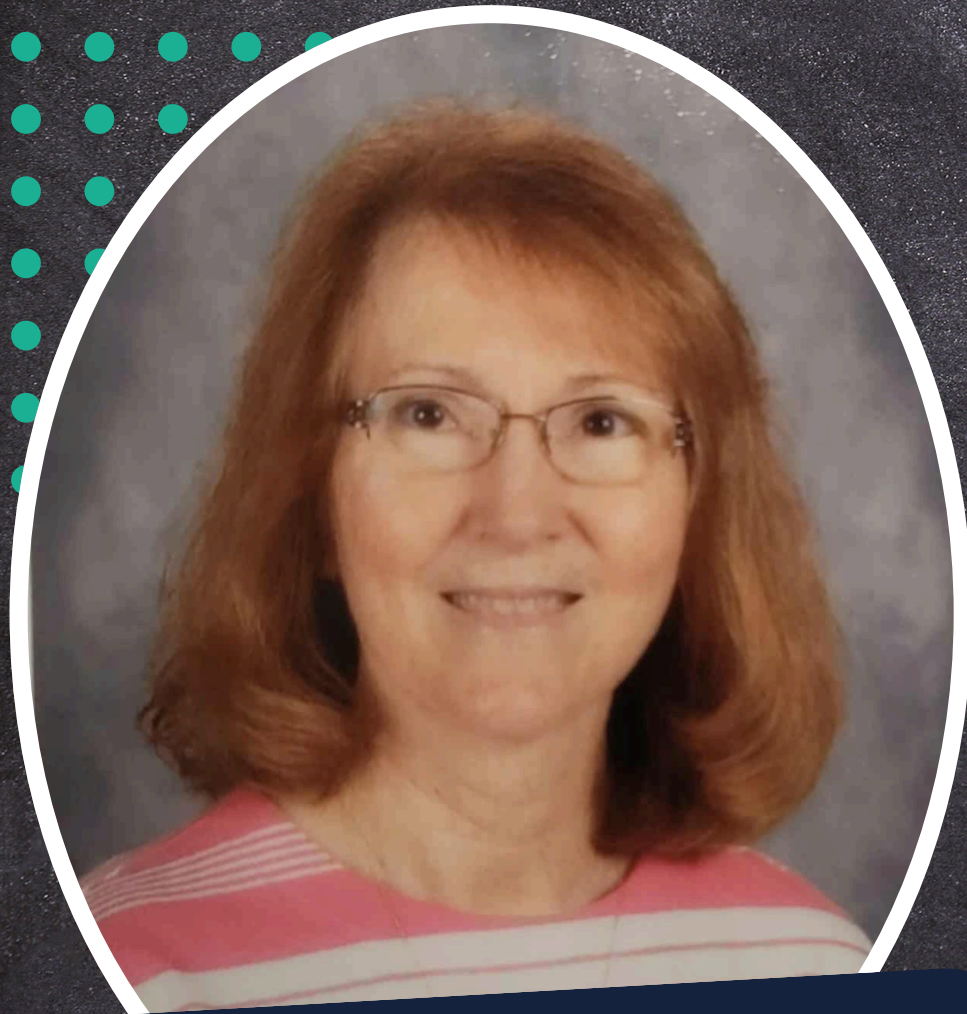

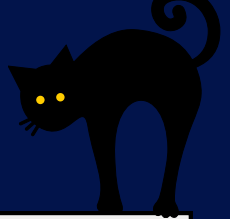
STAFF SPOTLIGHT

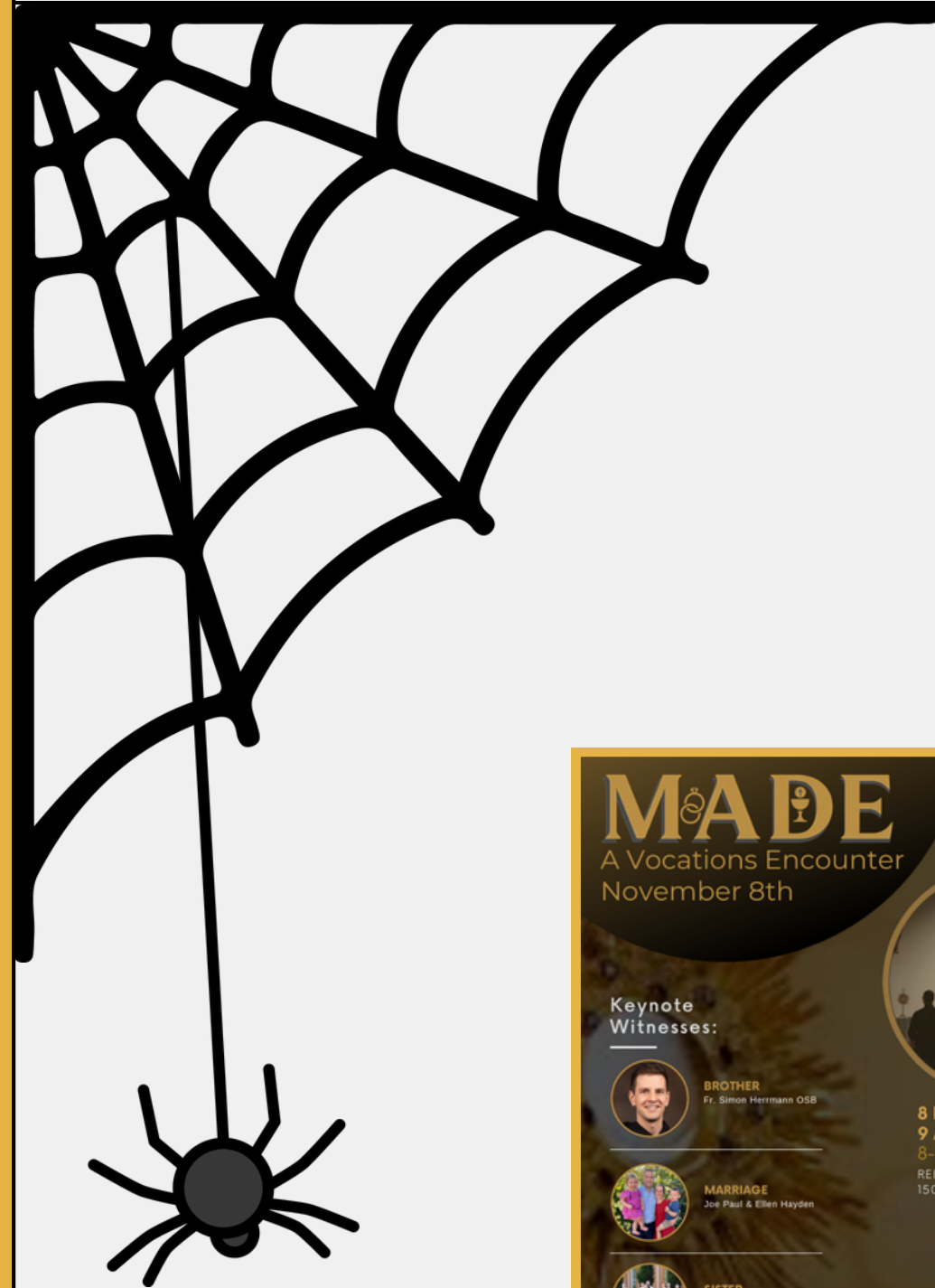
